Google Maps for BlackBerry is free, available in more than 20 countries and is really easy to install. It is compatible with any BlackBerry model with a color display, starting with the 7120 model and including the current BlackBerry Pearl, Curves and 8800 models. You will also need an internet data service from your mobile provider to have access to Google Maps and location information. You can download Google Maps in one of two ways: Advertising 1. Go to Google Maps and enter your mobile phone number. Google will send a link for download. 2. You can also www.google.com/gmm on your BlackBerry browser and follow installation instructions, which will be specific for your phone type. In fact, Google will do the test first to make sure that your BlackBerry model is compatible with Google Maps before trying to go ahead with the installation. Note that while Google Maps software is free, you can incur a fee for your data by using it to access maps. Your mobile service provider can provide more information about specific fees. Many companies offer an unlimited monthly data plan, and that may be the cheapest way to go if you get internet access frequently from your BlackBerry. Maybe you would like to try an interactive demo before you download Google Maps. You can try your computer by visiting the Google Maps website. You will be searching for locations or directions and see search results, maps and satellite images as they would appear on your BlackBerry screen. If your company offers Google Maps BlackBerry Enterprise Edition, you will be able to use all its features without downloading directly to your corporate BlackBerry device. Instead, your company's INFORMATION technology administrator will install the application remotely to your BlackBerry. When the enterprise option is updated several times a year, the administrator will send these upgrades directly to your BlackBerry. If you want to know more about installing Enterprise for your company as a whole, visit Google Maps. Once you have Google Maps downloaded on your BlackBerry, you'll want to start using it. Keep reading to learn more about its features. Install the app from Google Play and, while the installer takes the form of APK files, you are never allowed to download the file directly. Using the APK Downloader extension for Chrome, you can download any APK you need to have you have as a backup. That doesn't mean you can sneak into the store and start downloading all the premium apps and games that you've always had your eyes on. It's not a tool for piracy, but it will allow you to download for any free apps. Note: Use APK Downloader against Google's Terms of Service because it includes access to Google Play through means other than through the interface that is provided by Google. You can download a copy of the copy extension by visiting the Keem Code. You will need to click the right link to the latest version of the extension and select Save the Target as. To install the APK Downloader, click the menu button at the top right of Chrome and select Settings, click Extensions, and then drag the .crx file you downloaded to the extension page - make sure you drag to the center of the page to appear 'Drop to install' drop zone. Scroll down on the data that is displayed and under the JID entry, which shows your email address, you'll find your device ID in a six-family format. This gives you the same information. Enter all this information on the Options page for APK Downloader and click Login. Now you can go to Google Play and start viewing the available titles. When you find something you would like to download, open your page and click the APK Downloader icon on the right side of the address strip and save the APK like you would any other download. If you're having trouble downloading APKs, go back and double check that your device ID has been entered correctly - get it wrong and you won't see anything but download bugs. There is both a GUI version and a command line version that can be used to pull card data. All of this is written in Python, but the installer has to handle everything for Windows users. It's been a busy, busy week on iMore, and this time iOS headlines dominated the news with supposedly competing conferences - BlackBerry BlackBerry and Google I/O. The main topic of conversation this week was cross-platform messaging from BlackBerry and Google, as while making headlines was Google's response to the Game Center, Amazon taking to iTunes on the desktop, and the App Store finally hitting 50 billion downloads. Read on for a summary! The big story earlier in the week came from BlackBerry Live in Orlando. While we may have been expecting some corporate news that has affected iOS devices, we weren't quite ready for what would happen next. CEO Torsten Heins took the stage and announced that their signature messaging tool, BlackBerry Messenger (BBM) will be coming to iOS this summer. Some see it as too little, too late, but it seems to have a healthy early interest in the product. We'll be looking forward to putting it through his paces later this year. Now it also means, as noted by Renee, that every competing platform owner now makes applications for iOS. Apple, by contrast, does just nothing for any of its competitors. The posts have been talk of a city in San Francisco too, on Google I/O. Many rumors leading up to the conference, Google debuted its new, cross-platform, Google Hangouts messaging service, now available on iOS as well as Android and the Internet. Hangouts seems to combine the existing Hangouts group video chat experience with existing instant messaging service Google Talk. The third competing platform to announce the move to Apple products this week was Amazon. This is good news for Amazon MP3 Store customers however, how getting music on your Mac and iTunes is not the most convenient experience as it stands. I'm going to let you in a little secret that might shock you. Not everywhere in the world has internet coverage. I know shocking isn't it? Sometimes when you are in the armpit outside, admiring sheep and cows, you look at your phone and realize with shock that your mobile phone provider's internet doesn't stretch that far. That's why when you're going on a journey, you have to be prepared just like the Boy Scouts. For example, if you need a map then you need to download it to your phone in advance when you are still in an Internet civilization. With Google Maps, the process is very simple. Here's how to do it on the iPhone, but the Android method is more or less the same. As far as I can see, you can't do it on your desktop. Download Google Maps for offline access after you log in to Google Maps, look for your destination. For this article, I just entered Berlin. Now click the hamburger icon on the left side. These slides open the menu. What you're looking for is Offline Maps. Click on this. This area gives you all the saved maps offline. To make a new one, click the Custom Card button. The square will now appear above the area you just searched for. Move the area around to get the area you want to download. But depending on how large the area may be, you may have to download more than one map. Google Maps will show you how much space you have on your phone and how much space the map will take when downloading. If you have the area you want, click the Download button at the bottom. Choose if you want to be notified when the download is finished. If you are on a hard schedule to get out of the door on your trip, you can turn this on. Now you'll see how the download starts. You can stop the process at any time by clicking the Delete button. You can also name your card by clicking on the pencil icon next to the header at the top. Assuming you have a decent Internet connection, the download card is pretty However, you have to keep the Maps app open to make it go as fast as possible. If you close the Maps app while it's your map, you'll see it. When the map finishes downloading, you'll now see it in the Offline Maps section. As you can see, the map doesn't stay forever. It expires in one year. But when you click on the card you just made, you will see an update button. So if you're going to the same destination every year, you can upgrade your card and reset your expiration date for another year. On the other hand, if you decide that you're not going there anymore, you can remove the card early by clicking the Delete button. To use the map when you go offline, just open Google Maps and use it as usual. However, since you won't have the Internet at this point, the only part of the Maps app that will work will be the part you previously downloaded. Download.
