I've had a lot of problems with Firefox Synch screwing my bookmarks on my computer so that follows what I'm doing... ON YOUR PC: 1) Before using Synch on your computer: First backup of all your bookmarks. Firefox Synch is notorious for being both confusing and screwing things up. (Why didn't Mozilla fix this cumbersome nonsense instead of wasting our time with browser improvements no one wants or asked for?) To back up bookmarks on your computer... Copy and paste your Firefox profile as a backup or in your Firefox profile copy and paste favicons.sqlite (favicons associated with bookmarks) and places.json (bookmarks). OR Open the window of all the bookmarks on the menu toolbar. No menu toolbar? Go to individual mode and turn on the toolbar. (To get into customization mode click on the three bar icons in the top right corner of the browser) and select Tune ... Or click the right button on the Firefox bar, and select Tune... out of the window falling down.)
