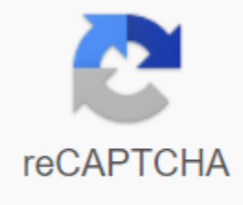

I thought I needed to dispel this misconception as the TMH General Research Guide is a kind of iconic guide to training IAS Prelims. Although the IAS Prelims has changed dramatically in Document 2 of the ICU Prelims curriculum since the electives were replaced by the GO document, the first document remains the same. The only change in it is that part of the mental ability has been transferred to the second paper. So now you need another guide for pre-preparation. However, this does not exclude the book you used to refer to so far for the first paper. Now there are several books on the market focusing on CSAT 2011, like the Pearson CSAT Guide of 2011, which are good because they balance both papers nicely. Also, part of Paper 2 concerning mental abilities, interpretation of data, logical reasoning, understanding was authored by Edgar Thorpe, who is the respected author of a well-known book on mental abilities and quantitative abilities, but I feel despite this TMH GS Guide is still relevant for the first work for the following reasons: THE TMH has the best material on geography, Science and GC among all guides This comes with detailed maps of soils, climatic types, etc. in the Geography section, which are very useful for prelims preparation A detailed section on Indian history covering all the important points in modern history For a good section on mental abilities For these reasons I feel that the TMH guide is still very relevant for paper 1 CSAT. In addition to this it also covers the mental abilities of a portion of the paper Even so, there are some areas not covered by the 2011 edition, such as: English Understanding and Passage Decision Making Interpersonal Skills It would then make more sense to choose the TMH GS Guide plus another book focusing solely on paper 2 CSAT. But if you don't want to refer to two books, then I suggest you get a Pearson CSAT CSAT which is also a good bet to call ahead. What are your thoughts? After all, you can't expect the whole book to be shortened in a few pages. This is, after all, a reference manual, but it does not replace the need to refer to the main books; at least not in the case of modern Indian history. Good coverage of Indian and world geography I have always felt that geography is the most well-represented and explained part of the TMH GS Guide, and this is no exception in this edition as well. All topics in geography, as economic, physical, human covered well along with detailed maps like those in. It's so good. Indian politics and managing Polity plays an important role in Prelims, and you can expect anywhere between 8-15 questions on it. TMH General Research Guide covers Indian politics quite broadly, including complex topics like Panchayati Raj, Emergencies and Amendments. In fact, all the amendments to the last are listed. Nor does it mention the current issues that are in the spotlight, such as electoral reform, women's representation and so on. You should still turn a good book for naked acts though and I recommend PM Bakshi for this purpose. The Indian economy in TMH GS Manual Economy is another important topic and facts and figures should be at your fingertips. The Indian economy coverage in the TMH Guide is not as satisfactory. The good news is that TMH has added a separate section on these 3 topics in the paper 1 reference guide. Each of the three topics has been comprehensively addressed and includes a lot of additional information. Another plus is that there are separate questions on ecology, bio-diversity and climate change after each topic. For applicants who want to know a good source for addressing this section, the TMH GS Guide is good The coverage of the General Science Science part has always been a plus of getting the TMH Handbook Guide and its no different this year as well. Each topic was considered comprehensively and separately in the sub-contents of physics, chemistry and biology. Useful tables on vitamin, disease, disadvantages, etc. are also included. A plethora of explanatory diagrams are thrown in as well as to assist in learning. If you cover general science well in the TMH GS Manual, you won't need to refer to other books for this purpose. The General Knowledge Section is pretty good Yes, the TMH GS Guide has an extensive section on general knowledge. It begins with information on various Indian states and provides useful information on the Indian space programme. GC has always been a critical component of the Prelims article and along with the Manorama Year of the Book, TMH's Guide is a good combination to create overall Knowledge. Useful Coverage of Current Events While applicants tend to focus on the last 10 months or so of current events that they need to know that now UPSC asks questions related to events that occurred years ago. And this is where the current events section in the TMH GS Guide will help you. It covers events from January to August this year, both domestic and international. So if you continue from this period you will have a good collection of current bits on events that occurred 1-15 months before Prelims. Overall, the TMH GS Paper 1 Guide is highly recommended for beginners as well as experienced ISU applicants alike.
