

Save this Owner's Guide and often review to continue safe work, as well as to instruct others who may use this machine. Page 8 6 - Use the right ball. Use only dimpled style JUGS. Lie-File, Softe, one ounce polybut baseballs, high-quality leather baseballs (9-inch Wilson A1010 equal or better), or tennis balls in this car. Periodically check the extensions and replace them in the time of damage. Make sure the extension cord is in good condition. When using an extension cord, be sure to use one heavy enough to carry the current your machine will draw. An unauthorized cord will cause the voltage to drop, resulting in a loss of power and overheating. The wire sensor size (AWG) is at least 16 recommended for an extension 25 feet or less in length. If in doubt, use the next heavier sensor. The smaller the number of sensors, the heavier the cord. Page 9 7 - Keep the car clean and free of sand and dirt. With the machine disabled, use only a clean damp cloth for Never use brake fluids, gasoline, petroleum products or solvents to clean the machine. - Tighten the lock handles and T-clamps securely after adjusting the trajectory. - Just work and store this pitching machine in a clean, dry dry Do not use outdoors if it rains. If the car gets wet, don't use it. The potential risk of impact exists if this machine is used at a time or after it has been exposed to water. The hand has dry surface water from the machine with a clean cloth and allow the machine to dry completely before its next use. Page 10 Save this guide. Refer to it frequently and use it to instruct other users. Don't beat pitching for those who have not been instructed to use it. If you are doing credit to your machine, make sure this guide goes with it. WARNING: Don't let your acquaintance with the machine make you be careless. Remember that a careless fraction of a second is enough time to inflict serious injury on yourself or others. 8 Ground instructions This product must be grounded! If it is to fail or break, grounding provides the path of least stability for the electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord equipped with a grounding conductor and a ground fork. The fork must be connected to the corresponding GFCI outlet, which is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and regulations. Don't change the fork provided. If it does not fit the socket, have a proper exit installed by a qualified electrician. Incorrect connection of the conductor of equipment-surface-ing can lead to the risk of electric shock. A conductor with insulation having an outer surface that is green with or without yellow stripes is an equipment-ment-grounding conductor. If you need to repair or replace an electrical cord or fork, do not connect to a live terminal equipment grounding conductor. Contact a qualified electrician or maintenance staff if the grounding instructions are not fully understood or if you doubt the grounding of pitching. Page 11 Figure 2 9 When working with an outdoor machine, use an extension cord designed for use outside the side. This is evidenced by the letters WA on the cord jacket. Before using an extension cord, check it on loose or open wires and cut or wear insulation. WARNING: Keep the cord away from the rotating area of the tires. Immediately repair or replace a damaged or worn cord. The electrical connection of your JUGS pitching machine is powered by a 90 volt engine (s). We don't work with this machine on a direct toe (DC). A significant drop in voltage will result in a loss of power and the engine overheats. If the machine doesn't work when you're plugged in, double-check the power.
