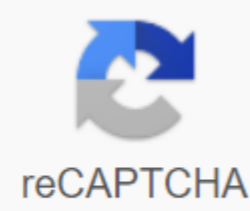




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Conair massaging foot spa manual

When using electrical equipment, basic precautions should be followed, including: Read and follow all safety instructions before using this device. DANGER 1) Always unplug this device from the power outlet immediately after use and before cleaning. 2) Not reached for a device that has fallen into the water. Unplug immediately. 3) Do not use during bathing or in the shower. 4) Do not place or store the device where it may fall or be dragged into the bath or sink. SAVE THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CAUTIOUS OPERATION • It is not recommended to use the Conair massage spa foot bath ® in the following cases unless directed by a doctor: Tuberculosis, benign and malignant tumors, hemorrhage, dermatitis, inflammation of the veins and thrombosis, open and fresh wounds, bruises, broken or varicose skin , er000-2015 calf pain or joint pain. • Consult your doctor if you have any questions regarding the therapeutic use of this foot bath. • Do not use before consulting with your doctor if you are experiencing innate pain or muscle swelling, or within 48 hours after any muscle or joint injury. • Stay away from children. • Stop using the massage machine if increased pain or swelling occurs after application. • If you are pregnant, please consult your doctor before use. SPECIAL WARNING 1) Do not use during bathing or bathing. use in dry areas. 2) Always unplug the device from the power outlet immediately after use and before cleaning. 3) Consulting doctor before use in case of illness or medical condition, including but not limited to the use of pacemaker and pregnancy. 4) If you experience pain in a muscle or joint for a long period of time, stop using and consult your doctor. Persistent pain can be a symptom of a more serious condition. 5) Never use any foot bath on open wounds, colored areas, or any area of the body that is swollen, burns, inflamed or where skin eruptions or ulcerative ulcers are present. 6) This product should never be used by any individual who suffer from any disease that may limit or completely inhibit the user's ability to feel or have any sensations in the body part that the product is being used for. 7) Do not use if you are diabetic, have poor circulation, or if any area of your foot or leg is inflamed or has an open wound. Consult with your doctor before use if you have any type of fungal infection, swelling, fracture or persistent pain. 8) Use this product should be pleasant and comfortable. Should hurt or upset the result, stop use and consult your doctor. 9) Never use while sleeping or drowsiness. 10) Make sure that your hands are dry when operating the controls or unplug them. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE/MAINTENANCE 1) Make sure the foot bath is unplugged and in the OFF position. 2) When transporting the foot bath, position the hand around the rubber handle for the safest suitcase. 3) Place the foot spa on the floor, fill the foot bath with warm or cold water, and plug into the wall socket. Never plug or unplug the foot bath while your feet are in the water. 4) The heat setting is designed to maintain the temperature of warm water, not to hot water. 5) Sit on a chair and put your feet in the water. Never stand in the foot bath. 6) Select the foot bath feature by pressing the on/off button. Choose any combination of bubbles and heat, and water jets. 7) Choose one of the 3 jumbo pedicure attachments and put on the post in the center of the foot bath. Put your feet on the attachment and apply pressure. Move your feet around to increase pressure and treat. The remaining attachments can be kept in the storage pane in splashguard. 8) Slip on the removable roller for a deep acrobath massage. The roller is removable - just select the roller out of the groove to remove. 9) To clean the foot spa, rinse with water. (Never submerge units in water.) Wipe with a damp cloth. Do not use any chemical detergents as strong as benzine. 10) Fill your feet with warm or cold water into the Maximum. Do not fill up on the water level index. Never fill. 11) Pour water out of the foot bath from the opposite side of the line wire. 12) Store 2 of the attachments in the storage compartment in splashguard. 13) Do not hang the device from the power cord. 14) Archives unit in its box or in a clean, dry place. Wrap loose wires around the foot of the bathtub. GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS This product must be grounded. If it should be or breaking, grounding provides a least resistant path for current, to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with equipment grounding conductors and grounding plugs. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate socket that is properly installed and grounded according to all local codes and ordinances. DANGER- Improper connection of the equipment grounding conductor can lead to the risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are suspicious about whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product - if it will not fit the socket, there is a suitable socket installed by a skilled electrician. This product is for use on a 120-volt type circuit, and has a grounded plug that looks like the plug illustrated in the sketch (Figure 1). A temporary converter that looks like the one illustrated in the sketch (Figure 2 and Figure 3) can be used to connect this plug to the 2-pole socket as shown in the sketch (Figure 2), if no socket is available. The temporary converter should only be used until a properly grounded socket (Figure 1) can be installed by a skilled electrician. Hard green ears or lug extending from the converter must be connected to a permanent ground, such as a properly socket box lid. Whenever the converter is used, it must be kept in place by a metal fastener.
