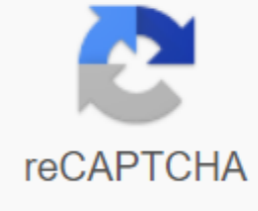

The former Lee district, the AA Highlands district, was dissolved with two members moving to the AA district of Southwest and another school moving down with Lee and joining a new district. This new area, which is part of Region D, is a clinch mountainous area. The 1990 Golf Team is the only team to win a state championship for school to date, in the VHSL Group AA.
