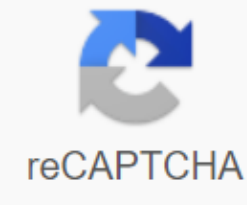

Marcos D'Souza: April 1919 - October 2016: Appreciation by Marvin Meisel Marcus D'Souza who died Hindhead, Surrey, had a distinguished service career in both Uganda and the UK. After completing a course for short, a climbing reporter and a book lover in Goa Marcos came to Uganda at the age of 17 to work at Imperial Airways that his uncle had arranged. He later joined uganda's civil service, and for a period of 14 years he took over as administrative secretary at the Ministry of Veterinary Services. In that role, he had authority over secretarial, clerical and accounting staff. He was also involved in staff affairs in negotiations with the head of the civil service while holding the position of general secretary of the Council for Consultation in Uganda's Civil Service. Improvements to the terms of service were promised during his tenure here. In 1957, Marcus moved to the Government Training Center to establish the department that would train secretaries locally, reducing recruitment to the sand. He trained more than 500 students and served as director of the center for a period of time. Upon moving to London, Marcus worked first for the International Coffee Organization in London and most recently for the International Cocoa Organization (both Bodies of the United Nations) who rose to the position of control officer in charge of regulating the world trade in these goods. In retirement, he was, for a time, on the staff of Sutton College of Liberal Arts teaching shorthand T-line to students and later also coaching journalists from the local newspaper Sutton. It had superfast speeds in this brand of shortness.
