


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Follow the steps below to make it Easy Origami Bird. Difficulty: Easy Origami birds with wings are usually harder than this, but this bird is very easy to fold. It only takes a few simple steps, and the result is almost as awesome as the more complex. This bird can also pass for a pigeon or pigeon. Step 1: Start with a square piece of origami paper. If you only have regular 8.5x11 paper, follow these instructions to make a square sheet. You can also use these colorful paper origami prints. Step 2: Fold the paper in half, folding the top corner into the bottom corner. You must have an inverted triangle. Step 3: Fold the part from top to bottom so that the edge is about halfway down. Don't make this flap too thin because it will become wings. Step 4: Turn the paper over. Step 5: Take the bottom corner of the top layer and fold it like this. Step 6: Fold the figure in half, folding the left side to the right. Step 7: Now fold the same flap back as this to make one of the wings. Step 8: Fold the other wing back as well. Step 9: Tap the center of the head and smooth. This is called the inner reverse fold. Step 10: And tada! You have a bird. Now free him! Just kidding. Don't throw it in the air. It will just fall and you will be disappointed. Click on Like below if you like this light origami bird! This beautiful traditional origami bird is actually quite easy to make, and if you fold your legs at right angles, it will stand! For the most beautiful birds, you can use paper that is painted on both sides: but white on the bird still looks good if you don't have any double-sided paper. Start with your paper white side up. Fold in half, as shown. 2. Fold the outer corners in the central line, and fold well. 3. Fold the top triangle back 4. Fold the corners of the model towards the center, fold well, and then open again. 5. Bring the highlighted angle up and out using the crease shown. Then bring the dedicated angle back down to the center line and smooth. 6. Repeat this step on the opposite corner... The model should now look like it 7. Fold the outer corners back to the shown angle and fold well. 8. Mountain fold the model in half. (Fold back) 9. Turn the model a bit so you can see the bird forming 10. Make these folds and turn around 11. Using these folds, inside the reverse times to make the head and tail of the bird. If you have folded your legs at the right angle (in step 7), the model should stand up. You can foul your feet if you need to. Ready bird! To crumple and open. Fold your right hand to the edge of the folds and fold well. Fold your left hand to the edge of the folds and folds well. Turn, as shown in the diagram. Fold in half to the back. Repeat with a left-facing angle. Now you have to have a square with two flaps. Now it's time to stand and the wings turn the square, so you have the diamond in front of you. Fold the base by about 1.5cm - it will make a little stand that will allow your paper origami bird to stand up. Fold in the sides about 1 cm - it will be the wing of your paper bird. Turn the paper over. And fold the top two flaps according to the photos. It's an origami bird's beak. Your main origami bird is now finished and will stand free!
