Francis Chan (b. 1967) is a former founding pastor and teaching pastor at Cornerstone Community Church in Simi Valley, California. After being raised by his Buddhist grandmother in Hong Kong, Francis came to America at the age of five. His mother, stepmother and father all tragically died before their 13th birthday. Francis came to know the Lord in high school and in 1994 he and his wife Lisa started Cornerstone Community Church in the Simi Valley. From just 30 original exhibitors, Cornerstone grew to 1,600 members by 2000. Francis resigned from his role at Cornerstone in 2010 - by which time the church had 4,000 permanent participants. He believed that God invited him and his wife to take a step of faith to begin a new service as an extension of the Cornerstone Church in a large American city. Since 2011 Chan focused his church planting efforts in San Francisco, where he participated in a multitude of Christian scholarships for life, a multiethnic, non-dominant evangelical church. At Cornerstone Francis has launched various and influential ministries, including Cornerstone Television and The College of Eternity Bible (since 2004). He was a highly sought-after speaker at many Christian colleges and youth conferences in the U.S. and internationally. His commitment is to teach directly from the Bible and his passion is to see a new generation of American Christians show a much deeper love for Jesus. Francis is committed to the radical gospel-oriented genesis associated with his own finances. He spends most of his income on charities, including royalties from his book sales and teaching resources. He is on the board of directors of the Children's Hunger Foundation and the Impact on the World. Francis used astute investments in restaurants and real estate to fund his mission of outreach efforts. Francis is the best-selling author of several books, teaching DVDs and study guides. His book *Crazy Love: Overwhelmed By The Merciless God* has surpassed a million sales since its release in 2009, and all proceeds are donated to charity. With an authentic message, a radical call for true faith and dare to fall over the heels of falling in love with God, the Crazy Love challenge resonated in the hearts of all ages. Francis and his wife, Lisa, have seven children, and live in San Francisco.
