

Also known as plant science or plant biology, botany began as people tried to determine which plants were edible, had medicinal properties or were poisonous. It covers a range of scientific disciplines that include chemical properties, development, disease, evolutionary relationships between taxonomic groups, growth, metabolism, structure and reproduction. Botanists study plant life at the biochemical, genetic and molecular levels of plants, studying cells, organelles, tissues, organs, populations and plant communities. Since agriculture focuses more on the commercial aspects of botany rather than on scientific, there is a separate section of the list of free textbooks dedicated to online agricultural textbooks. Traditional textbooks in this biological science, like most scientific books, are quite expensive and hard to carry around. Today's students are fortunate in that more and more scientists, teachers and academics are providing botany textbooks online for free. Written by James J.
