Xbox One Bluetooth ControllerThe Xbox One Bluetooth controller is fantastic all around, whether you're playing on a gaming laptop, PC, Mac, or Android device. Also, if you're into console games you might already have one. There's a reason why many of the other options in the rest of the list look like Xbox controllers. The design is tried and correct. It feels great in your hands with excellent control sticks and responsive triggers. The D-pad on the newer version of Bluetooth is much better than the original Xbox One controller, but for retro games or combat games there may be better options. The Xbox One Bluetooth controller takes two AA batteries and should last about 40 hours. You can also invest in a more eco-friendly Xbox One Play and charge kit that doesn't have enough durability in 30 hours. It also has a 3.5mm socket right at the top of the controller. 2. It sports the same look and feels like you're used to, packed with a headphone jack, touchpad, and more. If you're a mobile or PC gamer, it makes sense to pick up DualShock 4. Of course, it may not be as smooth a transition if you're out of the Xbox background. Sony has perfected its fourth-generation DualShock controllers with sensitive triggers and even better stick controls. The built-in light bar is another unique feature, although it doesn't do much of an off-set atmosphere for gaming sessions. SteelSeries Stratus DuoThe SteelSeries Stratus Duo is equipped with a battery pack that is designed for 20 hours of use. It's also considerably less colorful, with a sleek all-black look. The Stratus Duo is a lightweight and easily portable Bluetooth game controller. In addition to working on a Bluetooth connection, the Stratus Duo can connect via 2.4GHz wireless on Windows and Steam. This is ideal if your desktop doesn't have Bluetooth - just plug in the USB wireless adapter that comes in the box.
