As is the case, it is generally believed that profi ed reading depends on the ability to recognize words quickly and easily. When word recognition is difficult, students use their ability to process words too much, which hinders their understanding of what they read. Many educators in the United States believe that students should learn to analyze the text (understand) even before they can read it on their own, and understanding education usually begins with pre-Kindergarten or Kindergarten. But other American educators believe this reading approach is to be completely backward in very young children, arguing that children should learn how to decode the words into a story in phonics before they can analyze the story as well. The reason why reading is such an effective learning tool is that, like art, it teaches students to manipulate data to try to represent the universal. When a student reads a text, he is forced to add a large set of specific facts related indefinitely to seemingly random subjects (volcanoes, molecules, skateboarding, etc.) and assimilate them into the larger picture, which determines how they fit in or relate to the wider world. Mathematics, the diametrically opposed art, poses challenges for students in reverse; teaches them to manipulate the universals to represent the given. No matter what number 3 might come to stand - volcanoes or molecules or skateboarding - the listener will be able to manipulate these things since he or she is understanding mathematics. Based on this understanding, you might actually say that reading understanding shares a unique association between art and mathematics, each of which is a way to understand the world from a basic yet polar, perspective.
