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Therefore, the ability to interpret and build engineering sketches and drawings is of paramount importance. An engineer can convey his ideas in one or more of the three main types of projections, namely: Retographic projection, Projection or perspective of the projection, depending on the purpose of the picture and the person to whom he wants to convey his ideas.
