Start by removing the clothes from the dryer when they are slightly damp. Immediately hang them until they are air dry. By smoothing the seams and fabrics while hanging, gravity pulls some of the wrinkles. If you need to fold your clothes, do it as soon as they're dry. Even carefully placing them in the laundry basket and leaving them for several days leads to wrinkles. Try not to stick clothes in one of the comas and dresser boxes.
