Sharing exemplary assessment materials for reference purposes encourages fairly good teaching practices. Teachers, however, should closely monitor and monitor the issuance of non-assessment components from the previous year's examinations and the exchange of exemplary failures. This will allow candidates not to use such materials for their own work. The centres must keep the living materials for non-examination assessments secret, as well as the work of candidates in security and confidentiality. Teachers should not share live indiscretions with candidates or post candidates on social media. (Assessment not related to exams is defined as any work on a topic that has been established either by the awarding authority or by the centre of the current or future series of exams, even if the work was completed in the previous year.) Teachers should inform candidates that copying any non-expert material in order to present them as their own is negligent. Candidates should not submit a job that is not their own. For more information, see section 9 of the CCM's publication instructions for inconsiderate assessments. Teachers should not encourage candidates to help each other in the production of work. Teachers should remind candidates that they should not make their work accessible to others through any environment; they should not, for example, post and share their work on social networks (. Where the specification allows for some assignments within the group, paragraph 4.5 of the CDC's publication instructions for the inconsiderate assessments and specifications of the awarding authority should be referred to. The sample material prepared by the awarding body must be used in accordance with the instructions of the awarding authority. If teachers have any doubts, they should contact the awarding authority for subject to specific advice and recommendations. Teachers or centres may never use tasks and documentation for non-exam assessments for any purpose other than delivering to their candidates. Any attempt to use non-examination material for commercial purposes or any breach of the confidentiality of these materials would be treated as an abuse of office. The document also applies to assessment components controlled by CCEA GCSE, as well as components of the GCE AS and A2 coursework.

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
