Updated July 2020 you decided to cut the cable cord and go to streaming with the latest Android TV Box because you were told that you can get still great content at a fraction of the cost. But where is all this? The TV box usually comes as a blank sheet piece of equipment and it's up to you to fill it with the content you want. There are many ways to do this, but by far the easiest and safest to download are some of the amazing streaming apps made specifically for Android TV. You can download them to your Android TV Box directly from the Google Play Store. I came up with a list of the best streaming apps that you can download on your Android TV Box today. Some offer premium content, so you can expect to pay a subscription fee, but others are completely free. In addition to streaming services, I've listed the apps that are needed to manage the Android TV Box. Protect your box from malware, protect your identity while streaming, get the fastest buffering speeds, and optimize your image quality with these important apps. With all this content, never again say: All these channels and there is nothing on TV. Netflix's 15 Best Android TV Box Apps (plans start at \$7.99 a month) Netflix is an 800-pound gorilla in streaming video. There are more than 83 million subscribers in 190 countries. Seriously, is there anyone who has at least not heard of Netflix? What started out as a DVD rental service has moved to streaming media. About \$8 a month (\$9 per HD), you have access to thousands of movies and TV shows. If you have a device that they certified for 4K, you can access their small but growing library of 4K-UHD content for \$12 per month. The library varies depending on where you live, of course. But if you're looking for the most content that people actually want to watch, and original content like Stranger Things, Orange Is the New Black, or Money Heist, then Netflix is the easy choice to start this list. Find Netflix on Amazon's Google Play Store Prime Video (\$99 a year or \$8.25 per month) Do you think that Amazon Prime Video actually has more subscribers in the US than Netflix does? It's true. Amazon actually has nearly 20 million more subscribers in the U.S. than Netflix. I'm not saying you should ditch your Netflix subscription and go full prime on me. But, these two best streaming services complement each other well. Amazon has great original content like The Man in the High Castle and Mozart in the Jungle, as well as over 40,000 movies and TV shows. An Amazon Prime subscription costs \$99 for the entire year, which works out to be about \$8.25 a month. But you'll also get commercial free streaming music and free two-day shipping to any Amazon Prime product. Subscribe to Amazon Prime Video Free 30-Day Trial! ES File Explorer (free) you'll need some kind of File Manager for your Android TV Box, and ES File Explorer is by far the best. If you've read my tutorial on how to sideload apps on your Android TV box, then you're already familiar with this Android app. If not, what are you waiting for? Go check it out! ES File Explorer allows you to connect cloud storage accounts such as DropBox, Google Drive and SkyDrive to Box.net directly to your Android TV Box so you can view their contents and freely share files between devices. You can also use it as a task killer and app manager too. This is always the first Android TV Box app I install on my new devices. I believe this should have for users of any level of experience. More than 300 million people downloaded the app. They may be on to something... Are you satisfied with the power of the Wi-Fi signal? Are your shows and movies buffering fast enough that your viewing is never interrupted? If not, it may not be your router's fault. If you live in an apartment, your router can compete with your neighbor's router. As the Internet of Things is becoming more popular, the number of devices that throw out WiFi signals is growing exponentially. Let me give some statistics: There are about 15 billion connected devices in the world right now. By 2020, it is estimated that there will be more than 50 billion. That's a lot of signals bouncing off each other. This leads to one thing: the crappy Internet. WiFi Analyzer is a powerfully simple app that will help you optimize your router's WiFi connection. In my apartment, I found a tide of 15 different WiFi signals that compete for the same place. Some of them crossed paths with each other. With this app, I was able to quickly figure out which router the channel had the least intervention and made this change on my router. In less than five minutes, I was able to improve my internet signal, not just on my TV box, but on every device in my house. Download the WiFi analyzer from Google Play Store BitDefender (free version / \$49.99 for 10 devices) When my work computer starts scanning the virus, it slows my system down to scanning and takes forever to complete. I want my app to protect against Android viruses to do my job and stay out of my way. This is what makes BitDefender my go-to internet security program, not just for my Android TV Box, but also for my computer and smartphone as well. There are two main versions of BitDefender: the free bitDefender antivirus app, which covers one device, and BitDefender Total Security, which is a premium program that 10 devices and provides more security features such as On Install Scanning, Privacy Advisor, and Alerts for Malware and Phishing Attacks. Find out more on BitDefender.com Cody (free) I'm willing to bet you've heard of Cody, but just in case you don't: Cody (formerly XMBC) is an open source media player that lets you play any of your local content content Android, Windows or Linux devices. Cody's real strength is that it allows you to install addons and plugins that improve its functionality. Some of these addons are created by official Team Kodi developers, but most of them are made by ordinary people, just like you and me - with only better programming skills. You can use addons to access free content from CNET, Food Network, CBC, G4 and more. Find out more on Kodi.tv or see my full guide to setting up Cody Plex (free) If you prefer to have access to all media no matter where you are, then you'll want to dive into Plex. Plex is a media center that started out as a Cody option, but has since evolved into something even bigger. If you're wondering about the differences between Cody and Plex, check out this article. At the heart of Plex is the idea that you should be able to watch your stuff anywhere you are in the world. But what if you just stay in your own living room? Plex makes it easy to enjoy content on multiple devices from your TV or PC all the way to your smartphone and tablet, and all without having to have separate versions of the movie at different levels of quality. Plex handles file optimization work for each device. Read more on Plex.tv Sling TV (plans start at \$20 a month) Live TV: This is usually the first victim for a cord cutter, but there's a solution. Oddly enough, it comes from one of the big satellite companies: Dish Network. Stop me if you've heard this before, but the satellite company is trying to kill cable TV. The thing is, I think they got it right this time. What I like about Sling TV is that the same service will allow you to stream television to any device even if you're not at home. As long as your IP address is in any network in the US, you can access Sling TV. If you are outside the US, this may be a good time to get a VPN for Android boxes. For plans starting at \$20 a month, Sling TV gives you access to some of the biggest networks like ESPN, Disney Channel, CNN, USA, and SyFy. Some districts are also dropping access to local NBC and FOX stations. Sling TV is available on all your major streaming devices such as Amazon Fire TV, Roku, Chromecast, Xbox and Android TV, as well as on Android and Apple devices. Get a free 7-day trial on Sling.com Haystack TV (free) If you are one of those people who get your news from a different place than Facebook, then you should watch on Haystack TV. Haystack TV will stream news feeds from stations across the U.S. and around the world, according to your individual preferences. If you never want to hear anything else about Kanye West, then you can just it on your news feed. Personally, I wouldn't blame you. But, if he ever did anything important and important that affected the world as a whole, then the Haystack TV is smart enough to your preferences and show you that news anyway. But for example, I think you are pretty safe with your Kanye Ban. The idea behind Haystack TV is that you can quickly digest mainstream news from a few different perspectives, without having to sit through the entire broadcast of talking heads. Get a Haystack TV in the Google Play Store WatchESPN DA-DA-DA, DA-DA-DA Admit you just heard the ESPN theme in your head. © If you love sports and who doesn't, then you'll probably check out highlights on SportsCenter or ESPN.com at least once a day. The WatchESPN app allows you to access short video content and glare on your mobile device or HD TV, as well as a live ticker at the bottom of the screen. If you're still a cable TV subscriber, then you can access live content from every ESPN network here. Even if you're a cord cutter, you can still have access to live content via login from your ISP, although it's less likely. Special bonus: If you're already a Sling TV subscriber (see above), you can get full access to WatchESPN using a sling login. Download the Watch ESPN App from The Google Play Store Spotify (free and paid options, a maximum of \$14.99/month) Get access to old favorites and the newest indie music with the Android TV Spotify app. You'll need a Spotify account to get started - either a free version or your premium paid subscription. Once you've uploaded the app to your TV, you'll be ready to listen. Each subscriber has access to streaming music and podcasts, and those with paid subscriptions can also access live radio stations. There are no time limits on any version, so you can enjoy all the music you want. It's worth noting that, like many free streaming services, Spotify supports itself with advertising. If you can't stand the idea of ads, go with the premium version, which

is \$4.99/month for students, \$9.99/month for individuals, and \$14.99/month for a family plan with six separate bills. Download Spotify for Android TV from Google Play Store Mobdro (free) Mobdro searches the Web for free streaming content and delivers it to your Android TV Box. This app is not perfect (we'll get to that in a minute), but it allows you to watch TV shows, movies and other content without a cable connection. It also gives you access to sports, music, games and other streaming content. The main menu has a simple user interface with gateways for channels, news, shows, movies, sports, music, games, podcasts and more. There is even a section dedicated to animals. Now for the fight. Like many other free apps for Android TV, Mobdro can feel troublesome at times. He's lagging behind and it tends to update yourself, which will bother you if you prefer to update manually. Because everything you look at on is a live streaming, no episode menu. You can get around this by pretending that you are watching old-fashioned TV and choose a channel where you can see what is going on. Last but not least, different users have different experiences with this app. Some believe that it works well, while others eventually remove it. Some note that it works better with an ad blocker like Blokada. We recommend giving it a try - especially if you want to watch TV online for free. It's worth a try! Find out more and connect to Mobdro Blokada (free) Want to block all ads on all your Android TV apps? Blokada is one of the best tools for this work. If you don't use this app, now is a great time to check it out. It's free, open source, and safe. It blocks annoying ads, trackers and malware, protects your privacy and helps your device work more efficiently. Not getting too technical, here's a little more information about how Blokada works: It creates a local VPN that effectively blocks requests submitted to domains in its lists of URLs in the blacklist. You can use the app menu for white lists of specific apps and domains that are automatically blacklisted, and you can choose from different lists of URLs to block depending on the level of privacy you want. While Blokada is free to use, developers accept donations as well as input from volunteers who help keep the project in use. Find out more on Blokada View how it works with this tutorial from streaming Nerds BritBox (\$6.99/month or \$69.99/year) BritBox gives you access to a massive streaming collection of British television and movies from the BBC and ITV, all at the expense of a super-fantasy latte, and all in one hustle free space. In case you want to try BritBox before investing, you can enjoy a free 7-day trial to see if you like the app and content. If you're an Amazon subscriber, you can check out the free trial there. Before you sign up, contact the service to see if it is compatible with your TV box. It works well with actual Android TV boxes, but is not compatible with similar devices like NVIDIA Shield, Mi Box, Razer Forge TV, and Mi Box. View current programming and learn more about BritBox. Get a 7-day free BritBox Trial on Google Play Twitch (free and paid version) Whether you're a gamer who wants to watch live gameplay or you'd like to watch IRL or Esports gear via Android TV, Twitch is of the best apps for this job. While Twitch is a free service that supports itself, ad inserts into livestreams, Amazon Prime and Prime Video subscribers can get instant access to Twitch Prime, which offers ad-free viewing on the same channel of your choice, advanced chat capabilities, and some free games. You have to keep the channel you chose for 30 days, after which you can go to another channel without advertising if you want. If you are you Completely ad-free experience (except for content added by channel hosts), you can subscribe to rates that start at \$4.99 per month. Since some Twitch broadcasters add extra services to paid subscribers, you'll probably have more fun with this app if you opt in for the paid version. In case you don't mind the first page of the takeovers, but you prefer to enjoy ad-free browsing around Twitch, you'll want to look at Twitch Turbo, which is \$8.99 per month. Download Twitch from The Google Play Store Bonus App: CyberGhost VPN (\$72 per year to cover all your devices) It's a very good idea to invest in a VPN for your Android TV Box. It helps protect your identity and online security in general, from hackers who want your Netflix password or ISPs who want to nest your fares when they see you are a streamer. A VPN can also protect your identity if you choose to access pirated content, and allow you to access content that is geo-fenced. So yes, you can watch that amazing new British comedy currently only available in the UK. This won't greatly reduce the speed of the internet, so you can still stream all your favorite content without any buffering delays. But, with all the free streaming TV apps, you'll be limited in what content is available, or you'll need to compromise in terms of legality. If you want a 100 percent legal way to access the most popular TV channels, consider investing a bit in a subscription service such as Sling TV. What is the best app for watching movies on Android TV Box? If you are looking for an app to flawlessly watch movies from your own collection, then Plex is probably the best option on the market. If you're looking for access to a movie library, then Netflix and Amazon Prime have the largest collection of movies that are legally available for streaming and at a reasonable price. If you're looking for free access to the latest movies, a whole host of apps to help you do this. Investing in Cody is a good place to start. It is a free media center that can be used to organize and view content from almost anywhere in the world. Many community members have developed third-party addons that can unlock limited content. When streaming in this way, be sure to protect your privacy with a HELP VPN, and be aware of relevant piracy laws and the risks they pose. Can you watch a normal TV on android TV Box? You can access Netflix for a limited period of time through free trials and other promotions that come periodically. You can also minimize the cost of Netflix by grouping together with friends and family to pay for subscriptions and password sharing. Up to five people can use the same account at the same time. Is there a monthly fee for Android TV? No, there is no monthly fee for Android TV. Android TV is part of the hardware, TV box, and operating system. But Android TV boxes don't come with content already downloaded- it's up to you to download apps that will allow you to access the desired content, just like you do with your Android smartphone. While there are many Android TV apps out there that will allow you to access quality content for free, if you want to access premium content such as the latest movies and shows, you probably need to subscribe to a premium streaming service such as Netflix or Amazon Prime. They come with accompanying monthly fees that must be paid in order to access this content on your Android TV Box. Which free online movie sites are secure? There are many free sites where you can watch movies for free and that are safe in terms of just providing legal content. Among the best are Crackle and the Internet Archive. But keep in mind you'll be relatively limited in your choices because they will usually only be able to show films that are in the public domain. You won't find any of the latest blockbusters here. Verdict Switching from Cable to TV-box is all about release. Instead of paying a package for a subscription and then only watching two percent interest available, you decide what content you want and make it available to yourself. Yes, this means that setting up an Android TV Box takes a little more work than a cable subscription. You have to decide what it is you want and then track it down. But the process itself can be very useful. You'll be amazed at what you can do with Android TV Box and what content you can get for free, or for a fraction of the cost of a cable subscription. If you're not sure where to start, then start with my list of the 15 best apps for Android TV Boxes. They include everything you need to protect yourself and get the best performance out of the box as well as more than enough content, so you never find yourself saying there's nothing to watch.
