With a word-processing program such as Microsoft Word, you can print a document in booklet format if the document is two pages or more. Word will turn the layout of the document into landscape mode, so you can fold the pages in half, creating a spine similar to a book and read the document this way. Open the document in Microsoft Word. Go to the Page Layout tab. While you can choose the booklet print option later with the printer settings, you should first set up the layout of the page so that the booklet print options appear later. Click the Page Settings button. You can find this arrow in the bottom right corner of the page setting. Select Margin, then click bookfold on the Pages menu. Choosing a Bookfold layout allows you to print two pages on one side to make it look like a page in a book. Set up fields by entering numerical value in boxes Inside and Out. Then click the Sheets button behind the booklet to select the number of pages to include in the booklet. Your document will be adjusted to fit on the same page. Click on the File menu in the top left corner of the screen. The menu will appear. Click Print, then Properties. The options you can choose from will appear. Depending on the printer, check or control the Manual Duplex box. This allows you to print back-to-back pages or manually feed them on a printer. Select Print Preview. Clicking on this option allows you to first check the document in the format of the booklet. If you're satisfied with the layout, click THE GOOD button to print out the file. The printer will receive the file and print the document on two pages for each sheet. You can't fill at least half of the second page, it may be better to condense the details so that all your resume can fit on one page. Even if you add a second page, you still have to be as brief as possible to keep the reader's attention. Keep the most important information on the front page. A busy hiring manager may not be interested enough to get to the second page of each resume. Tailor your resume for each job application and include a cover letter to link your skills to an open position. Always be truthful about your past experiences. Employers will check your links and uncover any distortions. Create a personal form at the top of the first page so that employers know right away that they are looking at your resume. Include all current contact information such as your mailing address, phone number and email address. Add a second page header to define it as part of your resume. Include your full name and phone number and Page 2 label. Use a smaller font for a title than you used for the rest of the resume. Make sure the page breaks in the middle of the section. Keep the fields at 1 inch, and use a reasonable font for body resumes. Pages with narrow fields and fine print are likely to be pushed aside because they are difficult to read. Start your resume with an objective statement that summarizes your career goals. Use this statement to also highlight one or two of your most valuable skills. Instead of listing all your responsibilities and expect the reader to view all the resumes to find important details, add a short section on the first page. Choose five or six of your most important skills and list them with bullet points. Include any computer software or specialized equipment you own to impress the hiring manager for that particular employer. Focus on the last 10 years of your work history if you think listing an earlier position will help you get this particular job done. List the latest works first and include the employer's name, location, job name and dates worked. Describe your core responsibilities and list your key achievements during your time in the company. Try to use achievements that are measurable, such as increasing sales by 20 percent or reducing your department's costs by \$100,000. List your higher or higher education, professional certificates and other recognitions of your achievements on the second page. Depending on the type of work you're looking for, it may also be helpful to list the volunteer organizations or community service projects you've been involved in, you are already running out of space for your work experience and advanced degrees, you can omit this type of random information.
