

Put the password and accents (tildes) on the Bluetooth keyboard on Android. Using a virtual keyboard on Android is no more difficult once it is configured with the desired language, in my case Latin Spanish. On English-tuned tablets and cell phones, the keyboard is reconfigured so that it can display Latin symbols, so that in settings, language and input, the keyboard (current keyboard) changes in the keyboard and input menu. Turning off the pre-selected option (English - Android Keyboard AOSP) and choosing the right keyboard, in my case Spanish (Latin America) (Android Keyboard AOSP). This is a pretty trivial question at the end: you had to download from the Google Play Store a free package called Physical Keyboard Layouts, allowing you to choose the right language for Bluetooth physical keyboard, in this case havit brand 1. And that's it. I was able to use this Bluetooth keyboard correctly. Fortunately, I can see that there is no problem writing text in this way in the Kingsoft Office set.
