And how do you get that hefty mattress so neatly hidden and out of sight? Yes, Murphy's bed is pretty cool, allowing you to turn a home office or craft area into a mini hotel room. Best of all, you can return the room for your own purposes as soon as your guest leaves. Genius. So when we saw this DIY bed by Murphy Brooke at Creative Decor Brook, we should have known more. Here's what she had to say about the project. We just worked on it in our garage because we don't have a wooden shop. It took us about eight hours to build and then I drew it and it took about three hours. If it sounds do-capable for you (it's not necessarily a beginner project), Brooke recommends you remember the most important thing in making Murphy a bed mechanism.... I would search the internet and find the mechanism that you want, then it will have instructions on creating the right size bed. If you're not quite ready to build your own DIY Murphy bed, follow Brooke's advice. I started small with a drill and scrolled saw... and advanced to the table saw and router as I got more courage and wanted to try to do great things . If you want to improve your skills, start small and master one tool at a time, she says. Take a lesson from Brooke and remember: safety first! One day I drilled my hand... I was holding a piece of wood in my hand and drilling.... The drill hit a soft spot in the woods and zipped right through, and because I was holding it, my hand was next. She was fine, thankfully, but adds: Just learn from your mistakes and be safe. More truthful words were never said. Take a look at Brooke's simple DIY genius Murphy Bed. We purchased a mechanism for Murphy's bed and along with him came instructions on how to make it and the wood we had to buy. You can have closet doors made, but it's expensive, so I decided that we could make fake doors and drawers with just some trim and fake drawer fronts. Use the crown casting along the top of Murphy's bed to create the look of the cabinet door. Put the handles and pens on them and they look real. If you are shopping for one, you should consider several things. Mechanism Options: - Spring mechanisms are used in the traditional Murphy Bed system and usually consist of heavy compressed steel springs placed in the frame of the bed. They are balanced, which makes lifting and lowering the bed easy. But they need to be adjusted after years of use, as springs can fatigue and stretch over time. - Piston mechanisms use gas or air pressure to support the lifting and lowering of the bed frame. Unlike the spring mechanism, the piston mechanism can be locked when the bed is not used - a valuable safety feature. Piston mechanisms cannot be adjusted after installation, but compared to spring mechanisms, they experience much less fatigue and sagging. Chart: Murphy Bed Sleep Shop Mounting Options: - Floor Mounting is required in many systems with spring mechanisms. Installing Murphy's bed on the floor makes it extremely stable, but can permanently damage the floor. Murphy's outdoor bed is also very difficult, if not impossible, to move once installed. The installation of walls is most often used with piston mechanisms. Typically, Murphy's wall bed is attached to a stud and can be moved with minimal damage. Vertical vs. Horizontal: Vertical bed walls is what most recognized as Murphy's bed. Although it requires the ceiling to be high enough to accommodate a vertical bed, this orientation fits well into the adjacent cabinetry, like bookcases. A horizontal wall bed is well suited to rooms with lower ceilings (e.g. in the attic) or or with a smaller footprint (in which the bed can go down). Horizontal-style Murphy Bed.
