When you start Subway Surfers the goal is immediately obvious: It's the classic cat and mouse game, and in this case you're the mouse. You're running through claustrophobic tunnels and subway danger, collecting as many coins as possible as you do. The controls on the mobile are intuitive, moving left and right with a simple bump, or jumping and rolling over obstacles sliding up or down. The controls are familiar, but the game remains a challenge. As you run along the subway tracks things start to move faster, and a simple miscalculation can tragically end with a big streak. There are ways to ask for a second chance, but you probably won't like it; it either means seeing an ad or spending keys (a currency form in the game) to pick up where you left it. The more times he stumbles in any attempt, the more keys he will take to revive himself. And here the game descends into predictable microcontates. Nothing is really free, and Subway Surfers is predictably loaded with ads and micro-transactions. To your credit, you are never required to make a purchase, although you are strongly encouraged if you want to increase your chances of winning. More keys means more revive, and for \$9.99 you can clean yourself a good 50 of them, enough to stay in operation for a while longer. Of course, you can also play your coins in token boxes, another booty box system with random rewards. Coins in the game (which can also be spent anywhere between \$1.00 and \$100.00 of real money) can be spent to unlock additional characters, dresses or eye-catching skateboards. Some characters aren't terribly expensive (like Lucy, who only has 7,000), but others can take you a long time (Spike, Yutani or Fresh are based on the luck of the draw through Token Boxes). A character like Boombot can only be unlocked if you break up and spend money on the game. If you are in favour of getting your rewards in the game without spending a penny, you will need to keep a close eye on daily challenges and weekly hunts, which are ways to (albeit unpredictably) provide rewards for when specific moves are removed. You'll also earn coins for downloading some of the games you'll see in the many Subway Surfers ads: titles like June's Journey, World War Rising or Coin Dozer. The game also desperately wants it to connect to its Facebook account, and promises a free character (Dino) and currency rewards for doing so. Where can I run this program? Subway Surf can run on iOS, Mac OS, Android, Microsoft Windows, Windows 10 Mobile, Subway Surfers is probably one of the best endless runner games on your mobile, but if you're a fan of the genre you might as well check run run Run, Alto's Adventure, Temple Run or Temple Run 2, all of which are also free. Subway Surfers has set a new bar for endless runners, and for this it must be commissioned. Soft and addictive play is a staple of the genre, but you often don't get that much depth, player customization, or soft play.
