One of the main advantages of vector graphics is that you can scale it (make it smaller or larger) without impairing the quality. If you want to convert your logo into a vector chart, you have several different options to choose from. Scan the image to get it in the standard JPG file format. Use Photoshop Magic Wand or Pen tool to create paths around the logo. Click Make the way of working out the choice with the toolbar Path when you're done. Export the path (file, export, then Paths) and save a new vector file with a new name. You should only try this option if you are familiar with Adobe Photoshop because it takes some time to draw the exact path around the entire image of the logo using the pen tool. Use Adobe Illustrator (CS2 or later) to make the logo a vector of the image. Import the logo into the program and make sure it is selected. Click the Live Trace button in the Object menu in Illustrator, which will rasterize the image logo and convert it into a vector format. Download the logo file to an online vector converter (see Resources for the service example). This is the perfect choice for a beginner who needs a quick, simple method to convert the logo into a vector image. You may have to pay for the service. If you want to convert a raw SAM file into something more compatible with other text readers such as TXT or RTF, you can do so with Your Home Notepad program. When I work, I always use Illustrator to trace from a scanned pencil picture, although of course you can draw by hand in Illustrator. If you want to trace from a scanned picture, click File>Place and select a picture from your computer.02 Save as you goAs you work best to get into the habit of keeping your work as you go along. First, click the file to Save How... to name your file and choose where to store it on your computer. Every time you want to keep a file in its current form at any given moment, just tap the File, or use the Cmd's key label. I recommend getting into the habit of saving like this every minute, so nothing is ever lost if your computer crashes. You can repeat this process to save separate, new versions of the artwork as separate files. You'll see a large selection of tools in the menu on the left side of the screen (toolbar). Some of them, such as pen tools and mesh tools, may take some time to learn. But at the first start of the work I recommend choosing a pencil tool (just click N to choose it quickly - this is the key shortcut Pencil tool). If you have a Wacom tablet, you'll find drawing tools much easier to use, but you can still understand how it works with mouse.04. Your first form Drawing your first shape on artboard with a pencil tool Draw shape on an artboard with a pencil tool. When you're done you'll see its highlighted vector line, made up of vector points. Your vector line is highlighted by vector points If you draw a second form, the first will no longer be highlighted or selected. You can choose shapes by clicking on the black arrow of the Choice Tool (short V.05 key. By changing the look of the chosen shape, you can play with the way it looks. And the Swatches menu boxes (again, click Window>Colour/Swatches) allow you to choose colors for both contour and fill. Open the palette. In the top right corner of the Swatch menu window, click Open Swatch Library>Colour Books. Then I recommend starting with the Pantone process process for a good selection of colors. The mold tools are perfect for something more graphic than hand-drawn if you're not ready to be drawing in Illustrator, or want to create something more graphic than hand-drawn, form-shaped tools perfect. Use the shortcut M for rectangles and L for laps; There are still choices to choose from by keeping the Shape Tool icon in the toolbar. The free TransformAs you create forms you will see as they layer on each other being a vector, any shape you do is regulated regardless of everything else around it, so that the colors can be changed at any time. You can also change size or rotate the shape with the Free Transform Tool (E quick access key). You can use this tool to crush or stretch the shape. To change the shape without changing the shape itself, hold Shift while dragging. Unlike stretching an object in a pixel program such as Photoshop, there is no loss as a loss vector when you increase the shape of the vector. When you create shapes, you'll see how they layer on each other: the new shape will always be higher than the previous shapes when creating the image. In the layer menu box, you can change where the shape is by dragging it up or down in list.09.
