This tutorial is a simple floral napkin, but it is ideal for most parties or events. It's even better when you use different shades of the same color, so your table settings look like a giant bouquet! There are so many possibilities once you start learning how to fold napkins. You'll have tons of fun mixing and matching colors and patterns on napkins to create a unique new look. What type of napkin is best for folding napkins? For this project it is best to fasten paper napkins or high-quality napkins from fabric. As shown, we use paper napkins because they are flexible and inexpensive. If you want to get a little more upscale, then the fabric napkin works great for this design. A tougher napkin is needed if you plan to move the flower from the glass to the table. When buying fabric napkins to create these fun floral napkin designs, you will need a certain type of cloth napkin. Yes, not all fabric napkins are created equal. For best results, look for a mixture of polyester or cotton polyester. This will give you a tougher napkin that will keep the shape you are trying to give it as you assemble the design. How do you display my new napkin folding skills? I like to share how to fold napkins with the purpose of using them during a party. There is just nothing as much fun as seeing a person light up when they see that special addition to their place setting. First, you place one napkin in the glass and fold it in half so that it rests on the edge of the glass. Take a second napkin of the same or other color, and have the lid out of the previous napkin. Repeat this process of moving around the glass until you are happy with the size of the flower. If you want to leave a folded pink napkin in a glass, you can do so and leave it in each setting location. You can also carefully lift it out of the glass and display on the plate, next to the plate, or as part of the centerpiece on your table Prep Time 2 minutes Active time 5 minutes Total time 7 minutes Difficulty Easy Estimated cost \$1 Wide glass mouth (wine glass is preferable) paper or cloth napkins in the desired sizes and colors Fold one napkin in half, and place over the rim of the glass pressing the sides down the sides of the glass. Note: When using multiple size napkins, start with the smallest wipe first Repeat with the second napkin overlapping half of the first napkin Continue this process of alternating colors at will until you have placed 5-8 napkins and built a beautiful flower size. Once ready, you'll flip the glass so that the flower base is on the table or plate, and you can gently lift the glass out of the center leaving only the flower carefully remove the glass, and the down petals of the flower napkins until it looks like you prefer to display the flowers in glasses, on the plates, or as a center on the table of your Bound Paper Content Kawaii These lovely roses are perfect for high tea or special occasions but deceptively just to make yourself. Pink napkins are ideal for weddings, in particular; Silk napkins in red or white are the perfect choice for the occasion. Once you know how to make some origami wipe folds, you can use this technique as an icebreaker for lunches, showing people how to fold them - or teach kids who need a bit of entertainment. This napkin once quite forgives, because, as in nature, not two roses should be exactly the same. Fabric napkins are best suited for this origami pink napkin fold, however, some high-quality paper napkins can work just fine. Kawaii paper Although optional, ironing napkins before folding them will give your rose napkin a nice crisp, professional look. Start with a napkin folded into a triangle. It doesn't have to be completely ovary - it's best to fold the top layer a little lower than the bottom layer of the triangle, since it will end up even when you roll it up. Now fold up from the bottom edge. You can determine the height of the rose at this point. Taller roses will require thinner folds here, here. Short roses will have much wider folds. Kawaii paper Keep folding until the extended part of the napkin is about twice the height of the roll left at the top. Turn the napkin upside down. Now start rolling on the left or right side. Keep in mind the top edge of your rose is formed from the top edge of the napkin here. Keep rolling carefully until you reach the other end. Paper Kawaii Next, take a loose end and tuck it under the outer layer. You can use an oil knife to poke it under if you need to. Now focus on the bottom of the rose. There are two layers of napkins. Pull two layers apart. Be careful not to pull the whole rose apart. Kawaii paper Pull the outer layer and draw it around the rose, a bit like turning inside out the sock. The remaining sheet can be twisted and then pulled around the rose just like the other. In addition, you can pull the second sheet in the same direction as the first without twisting, giving it a double sheet on one side of the rose. This may be the best option for floppier or thinner fabric types. Like all origami, the practice makes perfect. The first couple of times you make your origami rose napkins, it may not look so good. Just turn it around and give it another go. Experiment with folding tightness; Sometimes the looser wrapper works better. Ohcrafts.net there are several different ways you can present your pink napkins. For a full meal, they can be placed directly on top of the plate or to the side. Another good way to present napkins inside glasses or cups. You can also fold napkins into cutlery pockets. 1 Turn the napkin completely. Then fold the top down about two inches (5 cm). Click on the crease with your fingers. The folded part at the top will be used to make the flower head. Using a desk or flat surface to work will make this step easier. 2 Hold the top left corner between your fingers. Pinch the napkins between the index finger and middle finger tightly. You fingers should be directed in the same direction just as. 3 Wrap a napkin around your fingers. Start with what's behind your fingers. Make sure the bottom wraps evenly with the top. Continue wrapping the napkins tightly around your fingers until there are about two inches (5cm) left and then stop. 4 Fold the flap in the top right corner diagonally to the top edge. This will create a small triangle on top of the valve. The fold will help to form a rose and create a small separation between layers of petals. 5 Wrap the corner around your fingers and hold under your thumb. Now the napkin should be cylindrical in shape. Make sure the top and bottom are about even in size. 6 Turn the base of the rose tightly to form a stem. fingers in the head of the flower. Keep the coil around your fingers in place. Use your free free to work on the stem. Pinch the napkins just below two inches of time and start twisting with your free hand. Once the base is safe, stretch your fingers gently. Keep twisting until you get about halfway down the stem and then stop. 7 Find the angle at the bottom of the napkin and gently pull it out so that it sticks out. This will create a leaf for the stem. Pinch the sheet between your fingers to keep it loose as you continue twisting the stem to the bottom. 8 Display a rose, or give it to someone special to make them smile. Making paper grown out of napkins is a great trick to know. If you ever need a flower and don't have the time or money to spend in a flower shop, this simple trick can save the day. 1 Turn the napkin. Open it all the way, so it looks like a big square. The folds in the napkin should form four smaller squares on the fabric. Place the napkin flat on top of the palm. 2 Pinch the center of the napkin between the index finger and middle finger. Place your index finger in the central crease on the top side of the napkin and the middle finger on the underside. The palm should be turned to you. 3 Fold the farthest part of the napkin over the index finger so that it rests on top of the other half of the napkin. The top of the napkin should be slightly shorter than the bottom. Keep the edges closest to you with your free hand to keep the napkin in place. 4 Turn the hand so swipe the folds around the inside of the index finger and middle finger. Keep the crease in place with your thumb. Then turn your hand back so you hold it with your thumb on the bottom and the index finger and middle finger on top. This will only leave your little finger and ring finger free.

5 Fold the napkin under the middle finger. Pinch your middle finger and ring finger together to keep the rest of the napkin between them. The rest of the napkin must now stick out on the back of the hand. 6 Wrap the rest of the napkin around the ring finger and little finger. Use your thumb to keep the end of the napkin in place. If you look at the back of your hand you should only see the middle finger on the outside of the napkin. All other fingers should be inside the coil of the napkin. 7 Pinch the napkin to form a flower head. Squeeze the napkin behind your fingertips with your free hand. Once you have firmly pinched the napkin you can remove the other hand from the flower's head. 8 Twist napkins to form a stem. Follow the folding instructions you have created to form the head of the flower while twisting the stem. After about one inch the stem is formed, stop twisting. The top of the flower should be able to remain firmly in place now. 9 Twist from the bottom of the stem. Leave one of the corners loose and start twisting the napkin to the base of the stem. A free angle will be used to make a sheet for the stem. Twist up to reach the desired size for the sheet. 10 Twist at both ends of the flower stem. The more you twist the thinner the stem will be. Just be careful not to twist so hard you break the napkin. Once you reach the middle you can adjust the flower stalk a bit so it looks natural. 11 Display a rose. This makes a great centerpiece for the table. You can also give it to someone special. It's a simple and sweet gesture. Once you get the hang of it, you will be able to make a paper rose napkin in just a few minutes. They cost less money than real flowers and they never wither or lose their petals.
