According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the county had an estimated 913,010 residents in 2015. [3] Demographics Duval County performed in the same way as Florida as a whole in higher education since 2010 in 2014. The U.S. Census Bureau found that 26.5 percent of county residents aged 25 and older had achieved a bachelor's degree or higher, compared with 26.8 percent in the state. The county's median household income was \$47,582 compared to the state's \$47,212. Residents of the province lived below the poverty line at a rate of 18.2 per cent, while the share of state residents was 16.5 per cent.
