

Just howt your iNow/Chalkable account and click on the unofficial transcript botton in the bottom left version. Once downloaded, you'll notice a number after your name at the top of the transcript similar to the following example: Dow, John - S909090. Step 2: Go to and choose Student All Sports Passes. Then enter your number (S909090) in the promo code section and click apply. Select number 1 and click Get Item at the bottom of the screen to complete the checkout process (you will only be able to purchase 1 pass. Once your card number has been used, it will not be valid again for another purchase.) Step 3: Use your pass at the gate when you enter each event.
