And that shouldn't change when the company reports Tuesday earnings. Analysts expect Home Depot to report a profit of \$1.33 per share for the fiscal fourth quarter, ended January 31, according to FactSet, a possible 14% increase from numbers a year ago. Sales are likely to have grown by 4% to \$21.8 billion. And, the results could even exceed those estimates. Why trust? There's home depot's track record: profits have exceeded Wall Street forecasts for eight consecutive quarters, and there are no signs of the winning streak ending. Home Depot also reports at the end of the results season, meaning investors already have a wealth of information from companies selling their products in their stores, including paint maker Sherwin-Williams (SHW), appliance producer Whirlpool (WHR), tool company Stanley Black & Decker (SWK), and cabinet maker Masco (MAS).
