Q. Is it safe to visit the Duomo in Florence after COVID-19? To ensure the safety of its visitors, the Duomo in Florence already accepts only online bookings. Several safety measures and guidelines have also been implemented to ensure the safety of visitors. Q. What are the safety measures and guidelines introduced in the Duomo in Florence?A. The social distance device, bearing as a marker around the neck, is designed with a sensor that is set to flash, vibrate or make a sound if a distance of 2 meters (more than 6 feet) is not maintained between visitors to the premises. This device is free for visitors and must be returned after their tour is over. They will be completely disinfected after each use.Q. Online tickets for Duomo Florence are available now?A. Yes. You can book your tickets to Florence as they already only accept digital bookings.Q. What is the policy of cancelling the duomo in Florence tickets?A. It depends on the Florence ticket you have chosen to book. While some tickets offer a full refund if tickets are cancelled up to 48-72 hours in advance, there may be no cancellation refund for others. Please check before booking. Q.
