More importantly, the questions are designed to teach you how to use your brain. And contrary to popular belief, you don't get off the hook when it comes to learning on an open exam book. You just need to learn a little differently. More often than not, questions on an open book test will ask you to explain, evaluate or compare information from your tutorial. For example: Compare and compare the different views of Thomas Jefferson and Alexander Hamilton, as they relate to the role and size of government. When you see a question of this nature, don't bother scanning your book to find a statement that summarizes the topic for you. Most likely, the answer to this question will not appear in any paragraph in the text or even on the same page. This question requires you to understand two philosophical views that you could understand only by reading the whole chapter. During the exam you won't have time to find enough information to answer this question well. Instead, you should know the basic answer to the question and, during the test, look for information from your book that will support your answer. If you have an upcoming open book test, take the next steps to prepare. Read the chapters in advance. Don't expect to find quick answers during the test. Know where to find everything. Watch the headlines and subtitles and make your own plan. This strengthens the structure of the text in your mind. To note all important terms with sticky notes and flags. If the teacher allows, mark the texts with these removable tags where you will notice important concepts and terms. Don't forget to ask first! Browse lecture notes on topics.
