Hours, minutes, seconds, and text can refer to spreadsheet cells. To convert the serial number, or decimal point of the day, into hours, minutes, and seconds, use HOUR (serial number), MINUTE (serial number) and SECOND (serial number). Each formula returns only a fraction of the requested time. Serial numbers can also be a text line, such as 6:30 p.m.). Excel converts the line into a decimal fraction before converting.
