It explains how our thinking becomes the law of our lives and that instead of blaming God for our suffering and our challenges, we need to understand the need to change our thinking, which in turn will change our lives. This is not as simple as it seems, but we can do with effort and practice. The goal is to understand that we are co-creators with God, and connected to knowing. Ernest Holmes (1887-1960) founded Religious Science, an important part of the New Thought movement. He studied Christian science and moved to Los Angeles in 1912. Holmes published his first book, Creative Mind in 1919, and followed it up with Creative Mind and Success, and then The Science of Mind in 1926. Holmes had an immense influence on new age beliefs, especially his core philosophy that we create our own reality. Ernest Shurtleff Holmes (1887-1960) was an American New Thought writer, teacher and leader. He was the founder of a spiritual movement known as Religious Science, part of the larger New Thought movement, whose spiritual philosophy is known as The Science of Mind. Born in a poor family in Lincoln, Maine, on January 21, 1887, the son of

Anna Columbia (Heath) and William Nelson Holmes, Holmes left school and his family in Maine for Boston at the age of 15. From 1908-1910 he attended Leland Powers School of Expression in Boston, where he was introduced to Mary Baker Eddy's Science and Health, as well as Christian Science. In 1912 Holmes joined his brother Fenwicke, a congregation minister, in Venice, California, to study the writings of many New Thought Movement authors. In 1919 he published his first book, The Creative Mind, and after almost a of touring Holmes dedicated to remaining in the L.A. area to complete his great work, The Science of Mind, published in 1926. The principles he taught inspired and influenced many generations of metaphysical students and teachers. In February 1927, Holmes entered the Institute of Religious Science and School of Philosophy, Inc., and later that year he began publishing the Science of Mind magazine. In 1935, he re-established his organization as the Institute of Religious Science and Philosophy, and in 1954 it was re-established as a religious organization called the Church of Religious Science. Holmes died in LA on April 7, 1960 at the age of 73.
