Genetic engineer salary us

Genetic engineers enjoy fascinating and generally well-paid careers at the intersection of biology and engineering, literally helping to design new life forms or modify existing ones by making changes in DNA structure. What does a genetic engineer do? Their work is overwhelmingly carried out in laboratories, although senior engineers can also have administrative or teaching functions, managing a team working on a project or appearing at conferences to present their work. Most work for corporations, although there are still opportunities in academia and a limited number of government agencies, particularly agriculture. Because science is a highly stratified culture, the initial salary depends on the nature of your degree. Graduates of the best genetic engineering universities are in considerable demand, and can have a significantly higher salary. This is not a field for autodidacts, because credentials count. The pay differences between those in the field with a bachelor's degree and those who have a master's degree become apparent immediately, and only expand as time goes on. Business Insider estimates that trading a good starting salary can make a difference of \$1 million for your lifetime earnings. At the level of genetic engineers with masters, the impact can be even greater. If your ambition is to teach, you'll need a PhD, but the corresponding job security isn't there. The Bureau of Labor Statistics needs to publish separate pay data for genetic engineers, but instead classifies this profession under the general heading of biomedical engineers. While the BLS does not maintain specific salary data for genetic engineers, the Payscale compensation research website does. According to this site, the average salary for a genetic engineer is \$86,992 per year, based on data from job openings and wages reported to the company. The starting salary for this profession is relatively high, with basic genetic engineers earning an average salary of \$75,000, while those working at PayScale. This rises to \$88,223 after four years. According to the National Human Genome Research Institute, the typical salary for genetic engineers is \$82,840 per year, with a range from \$44,320 to \$139,440. The average salary for genetic engineers is higher than the payments for those who work at the academy. While the median wage for all biomedical engineers was \$91,410 in May 2019, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that those working as teachers earned an average of \$78,480 per year. The National Human Genome Research Institute reports that students wishing to pursue a career in genetic engineering should take a number of classes designed to familiarize them with the subjects of cell biology, molecular biology, evolutionary biology, biochemistry and medical genetics. A bachelor's degree in a related field is the minimum education required to secure a job as a genetic engineer. It is generally much more beneficial to have a master's or doctoral degree in a relevant field. Most people entering the profession have a PhD in molecular genetics and experience of conducting their own research. According to the BLS, the rate of employment growth for biomedical engineers, and by association genetic engineers, remains very similar to that of other sectors of the economy. Estimates suggest that employment growth for all biomedical engineers will be in the region from 4% to 2028, representing an additional 700 jobs. As the aging population grows, it puts pressure on health care services to help people maintain a healthy lifestyle. In turn, this increases the demand for doctors, nurses and other medical professionals. But it also stimulates growth in other markets, especially pharmaceuticals, an industry where most genetic engineers are employed, according to the National Human Genome Research Institute. Wages vary by employer, but the median wage for this occupation is relatively high. In 2011, biomedical engineers averaged \$89,360 a year, the Bureau of Labor Statistics reports.
