All three options (railroads, roads and airways) are available, but not directly. You can only get to Arak through Visag, which is 115 km away. Trains will be the best way to get here while the airways will help you reach quickly, but you will have to fork out more. By rail: As mentioned above, there is no direct link from Mumbai, Delhi, Kolkata and other famous cities in India to Araku. However, the neighboring city, Vizag, is a prime Indian city that is very well connected to all the major cities in India. From Visaga 3 direct trains run between Arako and Visag and takes about 3 hours to complete the train journey. They work daily and provide stunning views as they pass through several tunnels and valleys. Don't forget to click memorable photos of your journey by train to Araku from Visag. On the road: Even on the way, you will have to get to Arak via Vizag. APTDC and some private bus operators operate buses, but the frequency cannot be relied upon. Most tourists prefer to hire a taxi from Visaga and drive for 3 hours to get to Arako. We offer the same as you get a great opportunity to click some amazing photos of your journey. The roads in are well maintained, but have sharp turns. Therefore, exercise caution if you are self-governing. By air: There is no airport in Araku, so the nearest airport is in Visakhapatnam. It operates both international and domestic flights. So you can get down at Visakhapatnam airport from anywhere in India or from abroad. Araku is about 120 km from Visag Airport. So you can pre-book a taxi or after going down at the airport. A 3-hour drive to Arako from Visaga can be amazing because of the view and pleasant climate. So check online and get tickets booked on Vizag from your city. How to around: Being a hill station, public transport is not as developed. So don't on them. To visit tourist spots in Araku, the best option is to rent a taxi. There are several local auto-rickshaws available at Araku train station, but they usually require This does not mean that you have to accept what they offer, negotiate and strike a deal that works best for you. Hire a taxi during the day and avoid the hustle and bustle of transport, roam freely, and just admire what Araku is famous for. Araku has a temperate climate and experiences all three seasons: summer, monsoons and winter. These seasons remain active for four months, respectively, and offer different experiences for locals and tourists. Although you can visit Arako at any time of the year, the winter season is the best time to visit the place because the weather at this time is at its most pleasant and you can explore and enjoy Arako to the fullest. Summer (March - June): The summer season starts in March and runs until June. It gets quite hot here, and humidity makes it worse for the difficulties. However, you can still visit this place in the summer because the weather is not unbearable. Just avoid visiting places in the middle of the day as it can get scorching and exhaustive. Maximum temperature can reach up to 40 degrees Celsius. On average, the maximum temperature remains at 35 degrees Celsius with a minimum of 25 degrees Celsius Monsoon (July-October): Araku receives precipitation through the southeastern monsoon, which usually starts from June or early July and stays active until September. August receives heavy precipitation, and it is suggested to avoid travel to Araka in late July and August. If you do, wear raincoats and umbrellas to avoid inconvenience. The temperature gets quite pleasant in the monsoon and goes down, reducing the heat and a difficult time. Maximum temperatures during the monsoon remain at an average of 28 degrees Celsius, while the minimum temperature remains around 22 degrees Celsius. Winter (November - February): The end of the monsoon in September marks the beginning of the most pleasant time of the year - the winter season. As a rule, it starts in October and lasts until February and early March. This is when you will love being in Araku with family, friends and loved ones. If you're lucky, you can also see shooting movies like Arako winter is the preferred location for shooting movies, especially Telugu. So just enjoy the beautiful weather, waterfalls, greenery, hills and streams. The maximum temperature in winter is 26 degrees Celsius with a minimum of 14 C. Araku has some really interesting places for tourists including caves, waterfalls, museums, gardens, coffee plantations, and so on. Site Visit - Borra Caves: About 36 km from Araku, Borra Caves are fascinating ancient caves that are considered considered to be 1 million years old. They are also the deepest caves in India and are located at an altitude of 1400 m. Caves are filled with stalagmites and stalactite formations of calcium deposits. The caves were formed due to the flow of the Gostani River over the limestone region. You can see the various formations of stalactites and stalagmites such as Rusha's beard, human brain, Shiv Parvati, and so on. there is a small temple outside the cave that has religious significance. Thus, a visit to the heritage in the caves of Borra should be your best thing to do in Arako. Experience the sensation - Chaparai Water Cascade: Chaparai Falls is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Araku at a distance of 13 km. This majestic water stream, also known as Doombridge falls, is surrounded by dense forest and offers scenic views of the surrounding area. This area around the waterfall has become a popular picnic spot because of the beautiful flow that flows through the wide rock formations. Interruption from smooth oblique rocks causes a huge natural water slide. And so this waterfall looks attractive and pushes to it numerous visitors. It is also one of the most preferred places for Telugu filmmakers and this waterfall is featured in many films.
