His wife Emma Raushenbach came from one of Switzerland's wealthiest families. Jung became interested in psychiatry and Worked at a psychiatric clinic in . Inch Inch He published studies in the Word Association that brought him to the attention of Sigmund Freud, with whom he developed a close friendship. Together with Freud, Adler and others, he helped establish the Vienna Psychoanalystal Society. In 1913, he published The Psychology of the Non-Aviation, which differed from Freudian concepts and caused a break in their friendship and cooperation. After the First World War, Jung traveled extensively in lectures on psychoanalysis and eastern philosophy in Africa, america, India and other regions.
