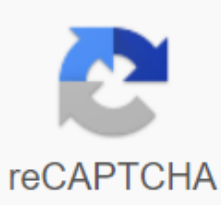

That year, the county recorded a total of 23,039 crimes. This represents a modest increase of 1.4% over the whole of 2016 and an increase of 17.9% compared to the whole of 2013. The crime clearance rate for law enforcement for 2017 was 42.95%. A total of 13,793 arrests were also made in the same period. Of these, minors accounted for 2,405 arrests, while adults accounted for the remaining 11,388 arrests. Incidents of violent crime reported in Ada County in 2017 include 4 murders, 155 rapes, 811 serious assaults and 93 robberies. There were also 1,177 burglaries, 6,577 thefts, 495 car thefts and 57 arsons. The five-year crime trend for the county shows that the murder rate remained the same between 2013 and 2017, while the rape rate increased by 9.2%. Robbery (50%), aggravated assault (19.3%), theft (19.5%), and theft (80%) increased as well. However, ADA County recorded fewer burglaries (10.1%) than in 2014. and arson (29.6%) during this period. Criminal Record The Idaho State Police provides criminal background checks for all counties in the state. It offers background checks based on name and fingerprints. To order a name check, fill out the criminal history check form by name, as well as the attached payment authorization form if you pay by credit/debit card. Send it to form along with payment to: Idaho State PoliceBureau of Criminal Identification700 S. Stratford Drive Suite 120Meridian, ID 83642A fee for each name based on criminal record check is \$20. In addition to credit/debit cards, the cheque and payment order are also accepted forms of payment. Please note that payment by credit/debit card attracts an additional \$1 processing fee as well as 3% of the total transaction amount. For a more complete report, select a fingerprint-based background check. This option also costs \$20. However, you will need to submit a completed criminal fingerprint background check form, as well as a complete set of ink and rolled fingerprints on a fingerprint card. Send these to the Criminal Identification Office address above. The cheque, credit/debit card and payment order are accepted for payment. The Ada County Sheriff's Office provides local arrest records upon request. This service only provides a person's record of detention at the Ada County Jail. Other records offered by the sheriff's office include police reports, dispatch logs, and motor vehicle accident reports. Use the sheriff's online public request form to request these criminal justice records. Idaho State Police maintains a state-level database of registered sex offenders. Members of the public can search this database on the organization's Website. Use the County Search feature to find registered sex and violent offenders living in Ada County. The sheriff's office also provides a practical resource for residents to find identification information about registered sex offenders living in the county. Visit the Ada County Sheriff's Office tracking page to search for these people by name, zip code, and street address. The only correctional facility in the county is the Ada County Jail located at 7210 Barrister Drive, Boise. His contact number is (208) 577-3000. The sheriff's office runs the county jail and provides a regularly updated list of inmates on its website. Use the search function to locate people who are incarcerated in this facility. To fund an inmate's account at the Ada County Jail, come to the stand at the sheriff's office. Cash, debit cards and VISA credit cards are accepted in this box. You can also deposit money online through the prison's Telmate website. Court RecordsAda has a District Court, a Juvenile Court, and a Magistrate's Court. The Magistrates Court has its own clerk and there are separate offices that handle probate, juvenile, and traffic cases. Call the district's phone numbers, juveniles and judges to in ask about obtaining their records. The Recorder's Office maintains all property records in Ada County. He is on the first floor of the Ada County Courthouse and his phone number is (208) 287-6840. The office is available Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Vital RecordsDivorce records are available from the Office of the Secretary of Ada County. Use the Secretary's Forencgram web form to request copies of your divorce decree. The employee charges \$1 per page for these files as well as an additional \$1 per stamp for certification. The Ada County Clerk's office also maintains marriage records for the county and can provide copies on request. Use the Online Marriage Application to request certified copies of your marriage license. Each certified copy costs \$2.The Idaho Bureau of Vital Records and Health Statistics provides copies of birth and death certificates, as well as divorce and marriage certificates. Available records include birth and death records from July 1911 to the present day and marriage and divorce records from May 1947 to the present day. To obtain these vital files, fill out a Vital Records Certificate Application Form (also available in Spanish) and send it, along with a photocopy of your identity card and a check or money order for the certificate fee to: Idaho Bureau of Vital Records and Health StatisticsP.O. Box 83720Boise, ID 83720-0036Ever certified copy of these vital files costs \$16. A photocopy of a vital file costs \$21. It takes 2 - 3 weeks to process applications after receiving them.
