Maple wood is commonly used for the back, ribs and neck of the violin. The wood spruce is used for the upper or belly of the violin. Spruce is preferable to the top of the violin because it is softer, so it vibrates more easily. The wood must be aged for at least five years, but the more the better. 20 years of aging is the most preferred, but that wood is more expensive. Below are the usual planes, and several finger sizes of planes. The aircraft is a formation tool used to remove wood from most of the wood. Favorite forms include Stradivarius, Guarneri, and Amati. In this picture, mold Guarneri, and surrounded by maple ribs that have already been glued to the corner and end of the blocks. in place around the mold. This completed stage is called rib assembly. The top of the violin (Top Guarneri pictured) is called the top fight. The lower part of the violin (above pictured) is called the lower battle. The middle part with two forms of C is called C attacks. ready violin, C fights are called waist waist A strip of wood called lining is glued along the top of each rib with only one side of the rib assembly. The linings provide an additional gluing surface for the plates at the end, and provide support for the ribs. Be careful not to put the lining on both sides. The other side of

the rib is the assembly where the mold is later removed. Above are two connected plates, which will later be at the bottom and top of the violin. Now they are ready for the violin to be cut. The first image shows the bulging plate. The second image shows the finished maple arch. Once the planning is complete, a metal scraper is used to smooth the surface even more and bring it to the correct thickness. Sandpaper is never used for this because, while the scraper cuts wood, sandpaper only makes it flat. The second image shows an example of the thickness of Guarneri's abdomen and back. (Image from Strad Magazine Vol 122 No. 1455 poster July 2011) The third image shows the measurement of the thickness of the maple plate using a wicketkeeper. Notice the sound holes or f holes previously cut on the spruce plate. The base bar is used to moisturize the vibrations of the lower strings of the violin, so as not to overload the vibrations of the higher strings. Once the pieces are glued together, cut the channel all over the border of both plates and paste the purfling. Purfling is a thin sandwich made of wood at the edges of the violin used for aesthetics and to prevent cracks from spreading. The second image shows the scraping of purfling to the desired size. Once this is finished, now you have a completed violin body. Guarneri's neck pattern can be traced on the maple neck block and cut. The peg box and the volute scroll are cut. Then the guest is attached to the neck. This image shows a finished lacquered violin with a chin, tail part, strings, bridge and pegs. An invisible sound pole inside, at the foot of the bridge.
