

Have you done all your Christmas shopping yet? At this time of year it is so easy to get into the trap of overfishing, especially when the gift gives turns competitively. If you have children in elementary school, you will know exactly what I am talking about. Chances are that the class representative in your child's primary created a group conversation on WhatsApp. It's godsend to learn about uneven days – especially the sort where your little daring need to dress like a character from your favorite book – or nativity play time. However, the digital equivalent of conversations at the school gates is also used to extract money. Ping! Can anyone bring in £10 this week's Christmas collection of Miss or Mr X and teaching assistants? Friends with young children report that £10 per child - so estimated at £300 per class - is quite standard for london state primaries today. Similar collections also take place at the end of the summer period. Our classic British way of not speaking openly about money issues, I discovered there is a deep pit of outrage over these demands. To be clear, no one doubts that teachers do a fantastic job and deserve to be thanked and commended. The chief handle is that gifts for teachers moved for the opportunity for their child to say thank you to one rival Show us. A friend begged me to write about this topic last week after she got the essay size a message requesting a fixed cash amount for the end-of-period collection. The organizer quite clearly said that parents didn't have to contribute if they couldn't afford it (but imagine that shame to admit it for a public group!). When you cough up money, the messages don't stop. Ping! We have collected £250 - thanks to everyone who donated, and see me on Friday if you haven't done so yet! But what do we buy miss/Mr X?A few other friends notice being slapped down in their class whatsapp chat dare offer to use funds to buy Amazon or John Lewis coupons. Ping! Coupons are pretty impersonal, aren't they? One felt like an answer: I'm in the middle of a meeting in town to discuss capital raising requirements, and frankly couldn't give a monkey what you're buying. Another father, who had too much time on his hands, offered to pay for a framed canvas in which all the children were wiped out by a message of gratitude. As the teacher is going to want to hang that in her hallway, my friend laughed. Few teachers are given envelopes stuffed in cash - although the escalation of generous gifts is not a bribe whisper about it. It was recently reported that some teachers at a (private) primary school in Oxfordshire were given Mulberry handbags by wealthy parents - possibly in the form of insider information to make sure their child is not back at the end of the camel next year with nativity play. The Teacher Toolkit website emphasizes that the pressure to donate gifts came not from teachers, but rather being driven by parents. Gifts are not expected and it is not necessary. This can also leave teachers and some children feeling very uncomfortable, it says, adding that only individual schools need to decide whether to implement a donation policy to stop seasonal evasiveness. One teacher in Scotland hit the headlines this Christmas when she wrote to parents asking they had made a class donation to a local food bank, saying it would teach children a valuable lesson about the spirit of odysseusness and kindness. They avoid the teacher eventually with more boxes of chocolate or bottles of wine than they can safely consume. These are usually the most common individual gifts - friends who are teachers say they are grateful, but they usually end up re-donating some of them. Others say that their class groups have given book tokens that the teacher can enjoy at expenses for himself and/or class. But by organising a collective gift and contributing to it, other friends are angry that some parents are still insisting on giving another Top. I say to parents - but too often it's mothers. Another common grip on friends' school group conversations is that these networks rarely include dads, but that's a whole different column. Most primary school pupils are also women. So, should we be surprised that the whole terrible industry, a seamless sentimental tattoo, has emerged as a custom gift from teachers? Some of the most nausea is the personal Christmas tree baubles, with the teacher's name and his child's name intertwined. Even worse - a personalized plant, labeled Thanks to help me grow. Or a desire bracelet, recorded in a message You need a big heart to form a small mind. Price tags are just as unattractive. By rejecting this rampant commercialism, parents still have many ways to express their gratitude. Some teachers say that the best gifts are those that cost nothing. A friend of the teacher's assistant tells me she treasures the home tag saying, Thank you for helping me with your work from a student who thrived after additional reading sessions. The last word goes to my friend Shelley. I think what many teachers appreciate most is a great letter, card or email to thank us for the well done work - even better if the letter is copied to your head, she says.
