The vibration they produce comes from quickly rotating a centrifuge inside the machine. Centrifuges are often used to distinguish two substances from each other. Plate compactors are most often used for paving and terraces, but can also be projects that require reliable compression for stable foundations. It is important to make sure that the ground is compressed before a paved surface is created. Otherwise, it is likely to become uneven and unstable on exposure to humidity, hot and cold temperatures, and the weight above it. How do disc compactors work? Plate compactors use powerful vibrations to compress material into the ground. There is a wide variety of plates available, with a number of different functions to help do the job, but they all have a flat bottom plate that vibrates on the ground below to compress it. Depending on the motor power, some machines can compress material down to different depths, usually 30cm deep. Operating a plate compactor After preparing the ground with a rake, turn on the plate compactor and use the handle to push it over the area you want to compress. Then, as if using a lawnmower, move the plate to the next strip of land and push it back in the other direction. Once the entire area is covered once, change the angle of the machine and move it over the ground again, this time at right angles to your original strips. Depending on the type of surface you are working with, you may need to add some moisture to the soil to prevent the plate from sticking. Built-in water systems make this easy to achieve. Machines must only be used with safety equipment, including eye protection, ear defenders, gloves and steel fog cup boots. Choosing the right plate compactor for the job Each job is different, but we create a variety of plates to suit your needs. How big is the job? If you are working with a small asphalt area, a single plate compactor is probably the best choice. But if you have a large area to cover, a reversible plate compactor will save a lot of time and effort. What materials are you working on? This will determine the eccentric frequency you need (how fast the plate compactor vibrates): Higher frequencies are a better choice for small aggregated materials such as sand and gravel. When working with asphalt, choose a plate with a built-in water system. If you work with clay-based soil, a frame is better suited to the job. Will it be used regularly? Gasoline-powered plate compactors are cheaper to buy, but have higher fuel costs. Diesel plate compactors on the other hand are more economical to run, but there is a higher initial outlay - if you plan for intensive use, they can be more cost-effective in the long run.
