US Attorney: 23 arrested, 3 in connection with drug trafficking operation in Horry County By WMBF News Staff | June 30, 2020 at 2:45 PM EDT - Updated July 1 at 5:38 AM HORRY COUNTY, S.C. (WMBF) - The U.S. attorney, along with federal, state and local law enforcement announced arrests in a major drug trading operation in Horry County. The arrests mark the first in Operation Broken Branch, which targets violent crime in Myrtle Beach and throughout Horry County. This is the latest interaction of three joint federal, state and local operations in this area designed to bring justice back to the citizens of Horry County and Beach, assistant U.S. attorney Everett McMillan said. The case was investigated by several agencies, including the FBI, SLED, Myrtle Beach Police Department and Horry County County Department. United States attorney Peter McCoy Jr. said authorities arrested 23 suspects Tuesday morning linked to a drug trafficking organization working from the Cedar Branch Area in Horry County. McCoy added that three suspects are still ongoing. We come for you and if you continue to sell your venison and shoot your guns here and perform gang activity at some of these clubs here, we will be looking for you, said Jeff Long, commander of Drug Enforcement. Authorities are searching for Tyshon Lamont Clifton, 20, of Loris, Lateice Laneice Griffin, 28, from Longwood, North Carolina and Timothy Mondale Long, 38, of Loris. This is not a safe haven for criminals, said Myrtle Beach Police Chief Amy Prock. The affidavit stated that the drug trafficking organization was involved in the spread of heroin, cocaine, cocaine base, fentanyl and opioid pills. It adds that the organisation had several sources of supply, middle-level distributors and street level distributors and facilitators. We're going to keep fighting and keeping them out of the city of Loris, said Loris police chief Gary Buley. Court documents show that agents and investigators working the case used several techniques to gather evidence that included court commanders on five target phones, seeking warrants from certain Facebook accounts and controlled drug purchases. We did this not only to get drugs off the street, but we did it for residents of Cedar Branch and Loris to take back their communities and feel safer, chief deputy Tom Fox said at the Horry County Sheriff's Office. Read the full affidavit below. Agents said during the investigation they not only grabbed a substantial amount of drugs, but they also seized more than a dozen firearms, bulk ammunition and more than \$180,000 in suspected drug money. The pandemic or not, there is no safe haven for criminals in South Carolina, Says McCoy. I want to praise the exceptional efforts of law enforcement officials who put themselves in damage for this morning's operation. With today's arrests, in the past six weeks alone, this office has charged more than 50 individuals for major drug trafficking offences or serious firearms offences. We can only do this through close relationships with our federal, state, and local partners. Arrests like this help take down entire criminal organizations so we can protect the people of South Carolina and help ensure they have safe neighborhoods to call home. The U.S. Attorney's Office said initial appearances for the suspects will take place over the next two days and will be made via teleconference with a federal judge at the federal courtroom in Florence. The hearings are expected to be around 10 .m. The suspects were arrested and charged in connection with alleged roles in the drug trafficking organization: organization: organization:
