The main effects of intra-specific competition are reduced population growth rates as population density increases. When resources are infinite, intra-specific competition does not occur, and populations can grow exponentially. Strong intra-specific competition and little inter-specific competition occur among the *Dipodomys* species. This discourages intra-specific competition and inbreeding. They found that parasitoides, microsporidial and intra-specific competition were the main mortality agents. Studies show that intra-specific competition can regulate population dynamics (changes in population size over time). If the disruptive selection is based on intraspecific competition, it in turn promotes ecological niche diversification and polymorphisms. There may be competition between individuals of the same species, so-called intra-specific competition, or between different species, so-called inter-specific competition. Intra-specific competition may also be involved in the mortality of browntail moths, as survival at low density was higher in several populations. Intra-specific competition is strongest when a species is favoured by the environment, while inter-specific competition is strongest when its competitors are preferred. As a result, a population's growth rate slows down as intra-specific competition which makes it a logistical growth model. Intra-specific competition is a form of competition between members of the same species. An example of intraspecific completion are plants of the same species (e.B. trees that grow very close together and compete for sunlight and soil nutrients. These plants, which compete for limited resources such as soil nutrients and water, are affected, especially in terms of their growth and structure. Some plants that can't get much sunlight tend to bend to the sun. Other plants adapt by growing larger or developing larger roots. Another example is the competition between territorial hard bees and male deer competing for mates. In addition to the direct interactions between animal species, there may also be indirect competitions. Indirect interactions that represent competition can be seen if, for example, a bear that has caught a fish from the river means that the other bears along this river would not be able to catch that fish, and therefore points to indirect competition. Intra-specific competition is generally stronger than inter-specific competition. One reason for this is the similarity of resource requirements between the same species. Intraspecific kleptoparasitism is an optional strategy that is beneficial to reduce time and energy costs. Intra-specific competition in pure stocks was higher for soya beans than for pork weed. The present study showed that significant intraspecific differences were found in the varieties. Intraspecific variability ranged from 0 to 76.5% of strains. We found little intraspecific variations in the frequency of wing rowing for both species. An intraspecific competition experiment was conducted in two nutrients in a common garden. The other form of competition is intra-specific competition involving organisms of the same species. When a tree species grows larger in a dense forest than surrounding tree species, it is able to absorb more of the incoming sunlight. However, less sunlight is then available for the trees that are shaded by the higher tree, i.e. inter-specific competition. Cheetahs and lions can also be in an interspecific competition, as both species feed on the same prey and can be severely affected by the presence of the others as they have less food. Competition is just one of many interactions of biotic and abiotic factors affecting the Community structure. Moreover, competition is not always a direct, direct interaction. Interspecific competition can occur when individuals of two different species share a limiting resource in the same area. If the resource cannot support both populations, reduced fertility, growth or survival can lead to at least one species.
