[1,2] Dermatophyta is a fungus that requires creatine to grow it, so dermatophyta-induced infections will attack keratin-containing tissues such as skin, hair and nails. [3] Tinea pedis are most caused by Tricophyton rubrum, T. interdigitale, Epidermophyton floccosum. [2.6] Tinea pedis is often associated as an athlete's foot due to the high incidence of athletes' feet, which is associated with wearing shoes worn on sweaty legs that cause a moist environment and facilitate the growth of fungi. [4] Tinea pedis is a yeast infection that is easily transmitted through direct contact with infected skin as well as indirect contact on already infected surfaces with the causing fungus. [4] It is estimated that about 70% of the population will suffer from Pydis Tina at some point in their lives. The highest prevalence of Tinier Piedis is found in people aged 31-60 years with higher incidence rates in men than women. Therefore, this infection is often referred to as the athlete's leg. Tinea pedis is very easy to spread from person to person. The spread is widely mediated by towels, clothing or floors. Some people are more susceptible to this infection if they have the following risk factors: adult men often wear tight socks and shoes for long periods of time using towels, carpets or clothes with someone with peas, not using shoes while in a wet public place such as a swimming pool or sauna. Diagnosis of TNpadis is based on medical interviews, physical examinations and supportive examinations. In medical interviews, there were complaints of itching associated with redness between the claws. There are red patches that arise in the area during physical examination. To ensure tinnitus infection, a supportive examination is needed in the form of skin damage that is examined under a microscope to see the absence of fungal spores.
