The plug must be connected to the appropriate socket, which is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances. HAZARD - Improper connection of the grounding conductor equipment may cause electric shock. Contact a qualified electrician or serviceman if you doubt whether the product is properly grounded. Do not change the plug derived from the product unless it is plugged in, has a proper socket installed by a qualified electrician.
