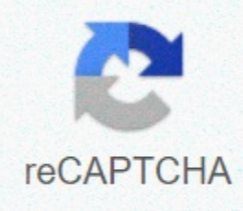

No garbage, recycling or yard waste collection on Thanksgiving Day No Collection on Thursday, November 28, 2019. (Peoria, IL) PDC will not collect any garbage, recycling or farm waste on Thursday, November 28, 2019. This does not affect the routes for Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday. For the rest of the week, please follow this schedule: • If you pick up on Thursdays, on Fridays. • If you are a Friday pick-up, place carts on Saturday. Make sure that the goods, cans and all materials in by 6:00 a.m. All the waste should be packed, including materials in the garbage truck. This helps to reduce waste across our community. Thank you 9 Reply August 31, 2020 The city's garbage truck, Peoria Disposal Company (PDC) will not collect any waste, recycling or waste on the farm on Monday, September 7. The service change is made in accordance with the Federal Employment Day. The weekday holiday will delay the pick-up by one day for the rest of the week. As a reminder, carts, cans and all other materials can be placed at 3 p.m. the day before collection, but must be out at 6 .m. on the day of pick-up to avoid collection. Find your schedule by entering your address on our homepage! We cannot guarantee an exact time every week. Please have garbage cans on the curb before you have the curb time of your area on the day of pick-up. If your regular pick-up day falls on an observed holiday, the service will be delayed by one day. Our observed holidays: New Remembrance Day Independence Day Work Day Thanksgiving Day Christmas Day Day We only accept coffee pots and microwaves with garbage collection. Please do not put any other electronic devices or electrical waste in the containers. Most municipalities organize special gatherings or drop-off events with local electronic recyclers for these items. Can I put paint in my trash can? No! Lead paint is not accepted and you cannot put liquid paint in your bin. It must be completely before it goes to the bin. To achieve this, mix with shredded newspaper, kitten litter, or a drying agent from your local hardware store. What is an administration fee? This fee covers the cost of compiling paper invoices. This fee aims to reduce costs through paperless billing. Customers can eliminate this fee by applying for paperless paperless contacted a customer service representative. Please put all recyclables in the shopping cart! Not contained in plastic garbage bags. Visit the Trash Collection Schedule Map and enter your address. Where do I put my shopping cart when? Your garbage truck is emptied every week. The trash can be placed at 3.m pm the day before collection, but must be removed at 6 .m on the scheduled pick-up day to avoid collection. After collection on your pick-up day, move your garbage truck out of the curb or alley no later than 17 p.. m. It must be placed in your garage/dandruff or next to your house or garage, it cannot be in front of or behind your house and your car should never be left on the street, the sidewalk or right of the way. Do you need a garbage truck? Click here to sign up for the Recycle Bin. Or call Public Works at (309) 494-8800. You can use your own container, less than 45 gallons, with a tight-fitting lid and handles or black garbage bags if you have additional garbage to pick up. Containers or garbage bags should weigh less than 50 pounds. There are no additional charges for the use of additional garbage containers or garbage bags. Bulky Waste Bulk collection Waste option as items that are too large to fit in your trash, such as furniture, mattresses, building materials, and large objects. These items can be picked up from your household at no additional cost. Simply place these items next to your shopping cart (with three feet of separation) at your curb or alley on your scheduled pick-up day. No loose items are collected. Note: If it can be placed in a bag, it can be it. Bulky items do not contain electronics or tires.
