One of the games I was most excited about is finally for all of us to check out, and that is Lapse 2: Before Zero. In this article we put together another wonderful Lapse 2: Before zero tips and tricks, so you can quickly and efficiently pass all your studies in order to reign for a long and prosperous time. If you are familiar with the first in the series (Lapse: A Forgotten Future), then this game is no different from that in terms of game mechanics and game style, so you have to figure out what are the good answers and what are ... the worst. But luckily for you we only have work for you with this Lapse 2: Before zero tips and cheats! So let's not waste another minute and dive right into it! Are you trying to get Ra's Eye and it's done that you might ask? Well, as in the first game of the series, the Creator will offer you in exchange for watching an ad, so it's basically free (and it only takes 30 seconds of your life). Make the right decisions To make decisions, you can swipe right or left and they will affect one of four statistics in a certain way. The catch here is that you never know if it's positive or negative, but if you think about it in a logical way, you could probably correctly guess which statistics will be positively affected and which in a negative way. Explore the pyramids At some point in the game, you will meet the Queen. It has a little secret that I don't want to spoil, but if your rule ended a few times (you died), you might know what I'm talking about. If you have no idea, then keep playing because it will appear soon. Read the story she has to tell (because it's very interesting!) and she'll come back after a few days (in game days, don't get it wrong) with an offer for you to go explore the Pyramids. You can explore either Sened or Userkaf and at the end you will be rewarded something that will affect all future gameplay. The ultimate goal is to explore the Great Pyramid, but it's a long way ahead. So focus and don't try to die too often. Always accept the cake From time to time, Nailah Midwife will give you a cake that she has developed. Always try to accept it because it will drastically increase all the statistics you have. So if you can, make sure you do this without hesitation. Can buy some boosts? If you feel like the game is too hard for you to deal with simple decision-making, then head over to the store and for a couple of dollars you can buy Eye of Ra, Heart of Anubis or a Sapphire fish. Also, if you're not a fan of ads (even if this game doesn't have a lot), you can opt out. If you really want to Money in the game, my best option that I suggest you go for is the Eye of Ra. That works just like Oracle in the first game, and basically shows you how decisions will influence the statistics. Get Get Lasting effects There are some lasting effects that you can get here, some of which are good and some not so great. For example, if you get the Warehouse effect, it will prevent you from dying when the meter people go down. In this tab here with lasting effects is also located the Eye of Ra. Other small Lapse 2: Before zero tips and tricks: - Do not repair the Pyramid that was struck by lightning, it will unlock an achievement. - Pet cat. It will prevent you from running away at first. You can also get some Sapphire fish to attract and make it easier to handle. - Meet the architect of the pyramids. It's a step forward in your advancement and governance. - There's a rainy season too in Egypt, remember? Try to live for as long as possible to be alive during the storm. This will unlock a small hole in the Great Pyramid. You'll see the effects it has on your future. - Meet the adventurer whenever you are offered the option. It's a great way to discover more about the game. - Chat a bit with the Creator if you want to wind off a little and learn more about the game. He's going to make a few jokes about his hair, but he's never going to fail to repay you. - You will sometimes meet researcher Kumiyo. Do you remember her? Good. Well, the fun part here is that the two games are linked, so try talking to Kumiyo as much as you can to find out all the information available. Talk to the queen. He's got a dark secret that concerns you, too. That's all I'm going to reveal, because I don't want to ruin the game, but rather to incite you to go and discover for yourself because it's mindblowing once you put all the pieces together. - Anubis, the God and Protector of the Dead, will sometimes reveal himself in the hope of making the rule a little easier (usually when you have made decisions with a pure heart). It will give you a second chance at life in exchange for you by following an ad. Go for it if you've been driving for a long time, otherwise just decline for now. When the blacksmith tries to make a new metal, let him do it! He will fail, but when he fails in the end he will reward you with good state boosts that you can use for either your army (gun) or trading it (for money). - If you went for the Slave Trade or if you met Hunger, that round is bound to end sooner or later. Queen Nefertari She's your partner in crime, she knows all about you, and she has a little dark secret that you most likely wouldn't have expected. A good lady. High Priest Tchanun doing typical high priest things, praising the gods and building temples. He will ask you favors from time to time, you can go ahead and make them, one will unlock the Continuous Sacred Temple Effect. The architect Pamiu The guy who built the Pyramids, talks to him whenever possible to try to discover all the secrets hidden behind their walls. Ahmuse Dancer She is an interesting character, always trying to bring the best of her beloved pharaoh. She's a good woman. Royal Hairstylist Ahsset The person in charge of the pharaoh's hairstyle, one who will give you from time to time an option to change it (yes, you can't see it), depending on your mood. Fun interactions. General Yuf Army General, one responsible for all business in terms of safety and sometimes work. He's a nice guy, so don't be too tough. There are some rivalries between him and High Priest Tchanun, but nothing as bad as in the first series of the game. Private Pawah A warrior for the empire, he is just a mere mortal being who will bring the typical demands. Help him if you can, don't change the game. Kah sculptor nothing in particular stands out about Kah, but some meetings are OK. Don't go crazy with the choices here as you might not want to lose everything you've built up to this point. Nehi the Scribe Like Kah the Sculptor, Nehi isn't too special either. But the game needs some of the characters who only have some normal meetings from time to time. Astrologer Kasmut Astrologer Kasmut speaks in tongues and has some strange requests, but go with the flow and you won't regret that the rewards will often prove useful. Dr. Ramose He has quite some interesting dialogues sometimes as he will make him choose one of the two people when deaths happen (and will), but he is a good guy deep down. Help him as much as you can. Pawero merchant This guy will offer you good deals from time to time, but one of them is trade in It's up to you if. If. Like getting the riches to lose from the people's side. It all comes down to your decisions. Nailah Midwife A good woman who will take care of the good of the empire and children. She'll help you, so help her as much as you can. Buck Adventurer This random guy looks like he emerged from the existence of even a Kinder egg. He's weird for this timeline and certainly not around the area. Interesting character. Nesumontu The Blacksmith He will often ask for your help in discovering new things and building weapons for the army, so I suggest helping him because he is one of the good guys and once his research proves a success you will have some good results and grow. Bek Noblinu my favorite character in the game, simply because he complains about his first world problems all the time. He'll have some decent tho rewards, so make the choices wisely. Sabu Farmer Farmer will often ask for tax modifiers and many things in terms of crops. Here you are free to choose what you like, again, this is not a game changer. Researcher Kumiyo You all remember her. From the previous game, she is the one responsible for time travel experiments. All you have to do is talk to her and put the puzzle pieces together to discover something amazingly interesting. Creator of the real game, he will (again) appear and give you the typical eye of Ra (such as the previous oracle version), which will help you predict the future of the choices you make. Maow Cat Pat it! Let's go! Let's go! It has a little something on it, but you can't just take it. You need to have some interactions with Maow Cat before you can continue to progress further. Anubis the ancient god, protector of the dead. He will appear when you make good decisions and they have brought you death. In exchange for a little bit of your time (30 seconds), it will give you the opportunity to reinvigorate yourself. If you died early enough, I suggest you don't bother with this, and do it only if it happened later in the game. These are all the characters that we've unlocked so far, but stay tuned because we update this very often as we progress through the game. If you've unlocked more characters, let us know down in the comments because we're curious you've unlocked them and around at what time so we can complete our Lapse 2: Before the zero character list.
