## Drake bell net worth

[6] He was born in Newport Beach, California, and began his career as an actor in the early 1990s at the age of five with his first television appearance on Home Improvement. Bell has also appeared in several commercials, such as the one for Pokémon Red and Blue, but is best known for his roles in Nickelodeon's The Amanda Show and Drake & Josh. Bell starred in the Trilogy of The Fairly OddParents films about Nickelodeon. Bell was the voice of Peter Parker/Spider-Man in the animated series Ultimate Spider-Man on Disney XD. In addition to acting, Bell has a music career starting in the early 2000s, at the time of his guest appearance on The Amanda Show, with the band Drake 24/7. He also co-wrote and performed the theme song Drake & Josh, titled Found a Way. In 2005, he released his debut album, Telegraph, released under Bell's own name. His second album, It's Only Time, was released in 2006 after he signed with Universal Motown Records and debuted at #81 on the Billboard 200, selling more than 23,000 copies during its first week of release. IT'S Only Time has sold 178,000 copies in the US since 2012. His first video album, Drake Bell in Concert, was released in 2008. He debuted in #81 the Top 100 of mexico's album chart. In 2011, Bell was 2011. In 2014, Bell released his third album, Ready Steady Go! under the indie label Surfdog Records. Ready steady go! In 2014, #182 debuted on the Billboard 200, and sold 2,000 copies in its first week of release. Early life Bell was born on June 27, 1986 in Newport Beach, California, the son of Robin Dodson and Robert Bell. His parents divorced when he was five. [9] Growing up in Orange County, Bell skateboarded and regularly attended punk rock concerts, whose music he cites as an influence. [9] Career 1991-2003: Movies, Initial Guitar Lessons, and Amanda Show Bell began acting at age five,[10] encouraged by his father who tried to put him in Little League Baseball and other sports without success before finding talent in public speaking and his confidence when posing as people to watch on television. [9] He declared, I was five years old, and my dad kind of said, 'Hey, you want to be an actor?' and I said, 'Sure,' stuff like that, you know? My dad kind of put me into it, but, you know, okay. I really like it, and I still do. Bell's first television commercial was for Whirlpool Appliances. I had to sit under a tree and eat ice cream, Bell later declared, I thought, 'I could get used to this.' [11] [12] His first appearance on a television show was in the 1994 episode Home Improvements [13] He appeared in the 1996 film Jerry Maguire and had a small role in the 1998 Seinfeld episode The Frogger [15] In 1999, he starred in a commercial for Pokémon Red and Blue[16] and the film Dragon World: The Legend. He was nominated for a young artist award for his role as Cage Redding in The Jack Bull, shot for television. He started playing guitar when he was 12. [18] He received his first official guitar lessons from Roger Daltrey when he starred with him in the 2001 film Chasing Destiny [19] From 1999 until the show was cancelled in 2002 [19] He also made a guest appearance on The Nightmare Room. [20] 2003/09: Drake & Josh, Telegraph, and It's Only Time Bell in 2007 In 2003, Bell landed drake parker alongside Josh Peck's Amanda Show costar in the Nickelodeon series Drake & Josh. [21] [22] His song, Found a Way, was presented as a theme song and is therefore included in the series' soundtrack, released on 22 October. During this time period, he appeared as himself on Nickelodeon's Zoey 101 in the spring fling episode, where he performed Highway to Nowhere, which is also featured on the Drake & Josh soundtrack. [23] [24] He also had the first of three consecutive wins at the Nickelodeon Kids' Choice Awards for Favorite TV Actor. Bell starred alongside Drake & Josh co-star Miranda Cosgrove with Dennis Quaid in Yours, Mine and Ours in 2005. [25] The Telegraph, Bell's debut album, was released on its own on 23rd [26th] The album includes 12 songs. All traces were written only by Bell with the exception of the song Highway to Nowhere. [27] [28] Being an independent release, the album was left without print and was re-released on 7th [29] Down We Fall played on an episode of Drake & Josh titled Number 1 Fan. Since 2010, Bell has performed with Hawk Nelson in a video for a Hawk Nelson song called Bring 'Em Out, which was featured in Yours, Mine and Ours. [31] The studio version was included on HAWK Nelson's EP Bring 'Em Out[32] and the special edition Hawk Nelson Is My Friend. [33] Bell performed in 2007 in 2006, Bell signed with Universal Motown. [34] Bell's second album, It's Only Time, was released on October 5th. Bell wrote all the poems, however, they were all written alongside C.J. Abraham, Michael Corcoran or both. [1] It reached number 81 on Billboard's Top 200. [36] It was also charted on the Billboard rock chart at number 21. [36] The album was more successful in Mexico, reaching number 4 in the Mexico Top 100. [37] It's his first album on the Billboard 200, and his best-selling album with more than 178,000 copies sold in the United States since 2012 [38] He released the lead single I Know, 17th [39] The video for the song I Know was released in October 2006. The single topped the Mexican music charts. [40] I Know also appeared on the compilation album Pure Love Songs Vol. 2 from 2010 [41] His song from It's Only Time, Makes Me Happy, peaked at No.3 on the Bubbling Under Hot 100 Singles Chart, which is an extension of the Hot 100. The song is featured in the finale of drake & Josh series Really Big Shrimp. [42] The song also appeared on Pop 100 at number 67[43] and on the Hot Digital Songs chart at number 45. [44] Due to the song's popularity, on October 16, 2007, a radio disney version for editing the singles of his song Makes Me Happy was released on iTunes. [45] He also introduced the theme song for iCarly, Leave It All to Me, with his Drake & Josh co-star Miranda Cosgrove. [46] The music video for the song was released on Cosgrove's YouTube channel Vevo 28. [47] The song took the lowest position on the Hot 100, peaking at number 100. It also peaked at the Pop 100 at number 83. He performed some Christmas songs in Merry Christmas, Drake & Josh, including Jingle Bells and Christmas Promise. The DVD, titled Drake Bell in Concert, was released on 16 October. The video failed to break through the 2008 or 2009 Top 100 in the US.[48] but the chart on the Top 100 mexican chart albums, peaking at number 81. [49] the DVD features live footage of him and his band on stage while they were touring in Mexico, recorded during five sold-out autumn nights. [50] It also features 2 new songs and five covers, all of which are exclusive to DVD. [51] In the spring, Bell had the lead role in the comedy spoof movie Superhero Movie. [52] [53] Bell recorded a theme song starring his co-star Sara Paxton for a movie called Superhero! Song, which was released on April 8, 2008. [54] In August 2008, the 2009 Olympics were signed by The Hague-1995 [56] Bell also starred in Merry Christmas, Drake & Josh alongside Josh Peck, who began production in July 2008 and premiered on December 5, 2008 [57] In 2009, his songs Unbelievable and Modern Times, which were shown on a Twalkin commercial,[58] were published exclusively on Myspace. [59] Bell also landed a role in the pilot for the then-upcoming CBS comedy series, Fish Tank, stating that Bell's involvement was what put the series production first. [60] However, the series was never picked up. [61] [62] Bell also had a third album, due for release in 2009, however, the album was apparently withdrawn and never released,[63] until it was released in 2020 as The Lost Album. [64] 2010–today: Movies, Reminder, Ready Steady Go!, and honest in 2010, he made a cameo appearance as Drake Parker in an iCarly episode titled iBloop and a guest role in Corbin Bleu's I Owe My Life. He played Timmy Turner in the live-action TV-movie adaptation of his hit animated series Pretty Strange Parents, A Pretty Weird Movie: Grow Up, by Timmy Turner!, released in 2011[65] and repeated his role in the 2012 sequel A Pretty Weird Christmas. On May 18, 2011, a music video for Bell's song You're Not Thinking was released on YouTube. [66] Bell's EP titled Reminder was released on 28th [67] The main single A Reminder, Terrific, was released on the 14th EP produced by John Fields, who previously worked with Rooney, Jimmy Eat World, Selena Gomez, the Jonas Brothers and Bleu. Bell said he decided to release The Reminder because he hadn't played new music for several years and the entire album would probably not happen until next year. [67] Bell also used Fields, an EP producer, for 9 songs at \$9,000 each, up to \$81,000 in total. Bell paid only 5 songs for 45,000, but only 4 songs made it to the EP. [70] In February 2012, Bell appeared in a YouTube video by Shane Dawson titled Drake Bell Kidnapping. [71] Bell landed the role of Spider-Man in the animated TV series Ultimate Spider-Man based on the same comic book. [72] He later repeated his role in The Avengers: Earth's Mightiest Heroes, replacing Josh Keaton, who originally filmed his role for the series. He also voiced the role of Spider-Man in two video games, Marvel Heroes,[quote required] MMORPG, and Disney Infinity: Marvel Super Heroes.[73] In 2013 and 2014, respectively. He was also in the Nickelodeon film Rags as Shawn from 2012. In 2013, Bell participated in an episode of the ABC reality TV series Splash, a celebrity diving competition, in which he came in third place. On November 11, 2013, Bell posted a studio version of his unreleased song Nevermind on YouTube. In 2014, he released the holiday single Christmas Promise on December 17th. During 2013 and 2014, Bell had roles in several animated films, such as The Naughty List, Adventure Planet,[Birds of Paradise][77][78] and Under Wraps. [79] Bell returned as Timmy Turner in the third The Fairly OddParents live-action film, A FairLy Odd Summer, which was released on 2 October 2014. Bell was nominated at the Capital Twitter Awards for twitter's biggest feud against Justin Bieber. [81] Bell also appeared on Takepart Live to discuss his bankruptcy other activities. [82] [83] Bell starred in an animated film called Frozen in time, which was released on 11th [84] Bell had his third studio album due for release in early 2013 [38] He then made the statement as a complete concept track. Entering the time machine and returning to the '40s and '50s on April 2014. Bell released his third studio album, his first rockably album, Ready Steady Go!,[86] under Surfdog Records, with whom he signed in 2012. [87] He was produced by Peter Collins and childhood idol Brian Setzer, frontman of the rockably revival band Cats. [88] He called the album an entry into DeLorian, hitting 80 miles per hour and back to the future. [89] The album's lead single, Bitchcraft, was released on 28 October. The single was remixed by French electro swing band Caravan Palace. [91] The album's promotional single, I Won't Stand In Your Way, a cover of the original song Stray Cats, was released on 17th [92] A cover of Caska Mouse Bull, released as the album's second single on October 8th. The single was included in Mexico's Radio Top 10 for several weeks. [93] The album was recorded entirely live. [94] It debuted and peaked at number 182 on the Billboard 200 and sold 2,000 copies in its first week of release. [95] Bell participated in the High School Nation tour in support of Ready Steady Go!, touring high schools across the U.S. The tour ran from 16 September 2014 to 22 October 2014. It started in Los Angeles, California, and ended in Charlotte, North Carolina. [96] Bell also performed at Exa FM's Concerto Exa 2014 in Mexico City, performing for more than 50,000 people. [97] Bell starred in 2016 with his Drake & Josh co-star Miranda Cosgrove in the animated film A Mouse Tale, which was released directly on DVD on February 10, 2015. [98] Bell starred in the slasher film L.A. Slasher as the Popstar, which was released on June 26, 2015. [99] [100] Bell recorded a song for the soundtrack of a film called Day & Night. [101] He also stars alongside Bella Thorne and Cameron Dallas in The Frog Kingdom, which was released on June 30, 2015 on video-on-demand and DVD. [102] He appeared in a documentary about the genre of rockability and its culture called It's a Rockability World! [103] Bell later repeated his role as Spider-Man in 2015's Disney Infinity 3.0. He also made a guest appearance on the episode with his Drake & Josh co-star Josh Peck on Peck's television series FOX's Grandfathered: [104] Bell is a guest as Kirk, a wealthy technology investor. [105] The episode with Bella aired in spring 2016[106] Bell will play Dan Orange, lead singer of a band called Orange and the Dead Ends in a new digital series called Dan is Dead. No premiere date has yet been set. [107] Bell recorded a song We're dead for the show. On January 1, 2015, Bell revealed on Twitter a picture of a broken wrist that read: Doctors say I'll never play guitar again, it's over. [109] Although the injury (caused by diving into the shallow end of the pool at his brother's birthday party) initially threatened Bell's further career as a musician,[110] he quickly recovered from the injury and returned to playing guitar. [111] [112] Bell embarked on a concert tour in Mexico starting on February 5, 2016, which ended on February 7, 2016. [113] Tickets sold out within minutes of online sales. [114] Although Bell started the tour in 2015, [115] Ready Steady Go! The tour will continue in 2016. [116] Bell toured high schools in the U.S. as part of the High School Nations Tour from March 28 to 29. [117] Bell stars in the 2017 film Bad Kids of Crestview Academy, a sequel to 2012's Bad Kids Go to Hell [118] [119] Bell released an EP titled Honest on June 30, 2017 [120] Philanthropy Since 2009, Bell has supported the Thirst Project. [40] a non-profit organisation dealing with the clean water crisis by raising awareness through education. Bell's contributions include public appeals [121] and fundraising concerts. [122] Seth Maxwell, founder of the Thirst Project, recruited Bell to be the 'face' of the campaign. [123] Bell also contributed to other organizations such as Toys for Tots. On April 22, 2015, Bell performed at the Strawberry Bowl in support of the cystic fibrosis charity Rockin A Cure. [125] Influences Bell described his music as heavily influenced by The Beatles,[126][127] The Beach Boys,[126] and Brian Setzer. [88] Other musical works and artists who influenced Bell include Oasis,[126] Buddy Holly,[128] Elvis Costello,[129] The Rolling Stones,[129] Led Zeppelin,[129] Jimmy Page,[129] Eddie Cochran,[129] Elvis Presley,[130] and Chuck Berry. [131] Personal life On December 29, 2005, Bell, then 19 years old, and his friend were driving from Malibu to Los Angeles when, as they stopped at a red light on California State Route 1, the two were struck by an oncoming vehicle. Although Bell's passenger suffered only bruising, Bell's injuries, while not life-threatening, were severe, including a fractured neck and vertebrae, a broken jaw, the loss of seven teeth and deep lacerations to his face. [133] [134] As part of his recovery, Bell required more than 70 facial stitches, had to have his jaw closed for two months and underwent chin and mouth surgery. [135] In 2007, Bell bought a 2,640-square-foot (245 sq m) house in Los Feliz for \$2,050,000. [137] After Bell filed for bankruptcy in California in early 2014, the house was taken under foreclosure. [138] [139] Bell is a cousin of former San Diego Padres relief pitcher Heath Bell. [140] In August 2020, Djevojka Melissa Lingafelt optužila ga je za verbalno i fizičko zlostavljanje tijekom njihove trogodišnje veze krajem 2000-ih. Bell je zanijekao takve tvrdnje. [142] Nakon toga je pušten na slobodu uz jamčevinu od 20.000 dolara i izjasnio se nevinim. [143] U rujnu 2016., Bell je proglašen krivim i osuđen na četiri dana zatvora i četiri godine uvjetno te će morati pohađati program edukacije o alkoholu; Bell je služio samo jedan dan za dobro ponašanje. [144] [145] Bell je ranije bio optužen za vožnju pod utjecajem alkohola 2010.
