By Daniel Westlake A movie soundtrack is one of the most important parts of a movie, but few people know how or where to download them. You can buy tracks on iTunes or AmazonMP3. But there are a number of online sites where you can download the amazing movie soundtrack you heard in this movie the other day. All you have to do is identify the film, the composer and check out one of these locations. An extensive database that goes beyond the opening theme song, the song over the credits or tune all the characters dancing to – it has the less remarkable numbers from a movie that only real fans will recognize. With more than 45,000 titles to choose from, SoundtrackCollector.com is for the serious musician and soundtrack enthusiast who is truly a fan of composers and the often brilliant and understated work they do for every film. With what may be the largest database of movie soundtracks online, ArtistDirect.com provides most of these downloads for free (with a fee to be paid for access to others). But most of the soundtracks that are the easiest to find are mainstream pop songs that have been bought for the soundtrack, not necessarily from composers who have made movie scores. Remember this if you are looking for something reasonably obscure. Last.fm seems to have the most tracks in his database - the challenge comes with finding these tracks. To use your Last.fm to track these free audio tracks, you'll need all the keyword information available to find them. Some of the titles are listed by film, some are performed by composer and others are just listed by title. Don't be put off if you can't find it in the first place – or just use one of the other sites listed above. Photo: PixarMy 6-year-old and I have been enjoying a children's book series titled You Read to Me, I'll Read to You. These books are formatted for two people to take turns reading different parts, like a script. Movie scripts are widely available on the Internet, there are several databases containing hundreds or thousands of titles, including internet movie script database (IMSDb), The Screenplay Database and The Daily Script.I would start with a movie that your child is familiar with, choose a simple two-character scene, and then assign parts (if you have three people, one of you can be the narrator and read the stage notes). Or you can teach your child to write their own script. Screencraft has an excellent guide to get you started. Some streaming services have been around for years without the ability to download tv shows and movies for offline viewing, but this functionality was available on Day 1 at Disney+. There are more than 600 titles to delve into, enough to binge hundreds of hours of The Simpsons without seeing even a fifth of what's available. Perfect for flight trips and thrifty data consumers, the service's download feature – exclusive to the mobile apps like this type - is so simple even Olaf could use it, and with every title that's justified, it's just a matter of figuring out what you want. Here we take you through the process of both downloading and deleting movies and tv shows from your Disney+ app. Explore Disney+ Downloading movies and series at Disney+ Step 1: Choose your download quality Before we have fun, let's talk about file sizes. If you're hurting storage space on your iPhone or Android smartphone, Disney+ includes a variable quality feature that allows you to sacrifice visual accuracy for a smaller digital footprint. Open the Disney+ app on your smartphone (iOS, Android) and click your profile icon at the bottom right. From there, you can navigate to App Settings > Download Quality. You see settings for default, medium and high, the latter probably offers no higher than 1080p resolution. Step 2: Download your content Because you can see all Disney+ title offline, there is no need for guesswork or filters to find downloadable content. The hardest part of this particular task is figuring out what you want to see. Once you've figured it out, all you need to do from the movie or show's list is press the download button, which is located far to the right of the Play button under the title logo. For shows, you can also find a separate download button next to each episode if you don't want the entire season. Disney takes care of the magic from there. It's a fairly quick download on Wi-Fi, especially on the lower grades, so you can probably snag dozens of movies in the few hours before your flight if you forgot to do it the night before. Step 3: Watch your downloaded movies and show all that's left to do now is enjoy yourself! An easy way to find your downloads is to tap the download icon, which is always visible at the bottom right of the Disney+ app. All your content will appear here, sorted by when you downloaded. Press the play button on the thumbnail of what you want to see and away from you. Episodes are listed a bit differently - embedded under a single label, and pressing it will present all the episodes you have downloaded for this show, grouped by season. You can also find these titles through regular searching and browsing. You'll know something is available for offline viewing if you see a smartphone icon where the download button usually sits. How much space do I need? The amount of storage space each title eats is primarily based on video length and resolution, and with other variables playing into the equation – the largest being your quality setting – this number can vary widely. We downloaded three films of the same length and resolution - a few of the Star Wars movies that clock in in just over two hours each - to see how each of the options affects file size. Empire Strikes Back on standard quality was 0.92GB for a 2-hour, 7-minute runtime, while A New Hope on medium needed 1.4GB for 2 hours and 4 minutes. That's a modest leap compared to High Quality Return of the Jedi, which needed 5.5GB in 2 hours and 14 minutes. For shows, a 39-minute episode of The Mandalorian on high quality takes 1.5GB, but only 270MB on standard and 424MB on medium. Finally, on a 3-hour, 1-minute runtime, The Avengers: End Game needs a whopping 7.1GB. Using the above data, you can find a rough estimate of how much space you need to store everything you want. You can mix and match by adjusting the quality setting before you start the download. Now would also be an excellent time to set whether you need a Wi-Fi connection to download content, an option those on limited data should definitely consider. Disney+ enables wi-fi downloads by default. What is available? As explained above, everything in the Disney+ catalog can be downloaded for offline consumption. Whether it's a full season of Darkwing Duck or every movie from the Marvel Cinematic Universe, if it's at Disney+, you can download it. Unlike some other services, Disney+ is pretty loose for restrictions. For starters, you can download a single title of up to 10 different devices at a time, and you can download any of them as often as you like. The only thing Disney asks is that you connect to Disney+ every 30 days. How do I delete titles? Finally, you want to make room for something new. Whether you want to delete a single title or a bunch at once, Disney+ makes the task delightfully simple. Step 1: Deleting a single title When you want to delete titles from your device, the process is much more straightforward than downloading files. In fact, it will take you just a few seconds to delete something from Disney+. First, find your content by going to the download section. You can access the download area by tapping the second icon from the right side of the app's navigation bar. Find the movie you want to delete, and on the smartphone icon to the right of its Choose Remove Download, and the title will escort itself right from your smartphones storage. If you delete some selected movies or series, this is a simple way to do it. Step 2: Deleting all titles that Disney+ makes it easy to remove multiple titles at once from the platform. In fact, there are actually two different ways you can do this. When you're in the Downloads section, you can click the Edit button in the upper-right corner of the screen. You want more fields to appear next to your titles, and you can tap a square to select the corresponding title. After you select all the titles you want to delete, tap the Recycle Bin. Similarly, you can also tap the Select All button to select all the titles to delete. If you tap it one more time, all your titles will be deselected. If you're looking for an even faster solution for mass deletion, Disney+ offers it. You can tap your profile icon at the bottom right and tap App Settings > Delete All Downloads. This option allows you to throw away everything with one button — so there's more room for the new titles you want to download next time.
