The amount of work depends on the size of the organization you are criticizing. Larger organizations require more complex and time-consuming policies and procedures. Some small businesses may not have it at all. To accomplish this task successfully, you need to understand the process and purpose of the review. Determine why policies and procedures are applied in the first place. Criticism is often required because of the challenges organizations face, such as accusations of sexual harassment and discrimination in promoting the practices of internal employees. Sometimes policies and procedures are simply reviewed to keep the current business environment and laws up-to-date. For example, you might decide that your company needs to add policies and procedures for posting company-related information to blogs and social networking websites. To know the purpose is essential to success. Identify who is writing the review and what they expect. Your review will be most effective if you address all the reviewer's concerns. Write your review clearly and concisely. Use specific examples to support your points. Be objective and fair. Avoid making personal attacks. Remember that the goal is to improve the way things are done, not to punish anyone. Understand what something means or why something exists. If you have questions about policies and procedures, investigate their effectiveness and importance. Many large organizations have legal departments that can answer questions about why a particular policy exists. Otherwise, please contact an external lawyer if necessary to speak with a human resources representative or to confirm legal questions. When you're done reviewing your current policies and procedures, write a review. Include the pros and cons of an existing policy and recommendations for adding or removing it. Please edit your review for the cleanliness of spelling, grammar and ideas. Please submit it to the individual who requested the review. Tip Writing a review is a time-consuming and detailed task. Make sure you have enough time to do your job well. Also, few people like to criticize the work, so it may be against it if the criticism is reviewed. This is expected. Congress has overwhelmingly approved a bill that would ban states from ordering shots for at least the next four years. Governor Perry allowed the bill to become law without his signature in early May. In February, Governor Perry signed an administrative order demanding that the shots be fired, but many lawmakers opposed the move, noting that parents should decide whether to vaccinate against sexually transmitted diseases. The Texas Medical Association (TMA) did not support the state's order, despite the science behind the HPV vaccine is strong and doctors are excited to prevent about 70 percent of cervical cancer cases and 90 percent of cases of genital chitosis. TMA President William Hinchey said in a statement. Oklahoma Governor Brad Henry (D)'s tort reforms have recently rejected tort reform measures that limit non-economic damage in medical error cases to a maximum of 300,000 dollars. But the governor has left open to the possibility of signing a compromise reform package in the future. Governor Henry vetoed SB.507, ignoring concern that some provisions of the bill were unconstitutional and not enough to curb the down payments. The key to curbing pleading lawsuits is to stop them on the front end of the legal system without limiting the damages and penalties given on the back end after the conviction is handed down, he said in a statement. The bill was supported by the Oklahoma Medical Association. Contraceptive coverage is preferred, with more than 80 percent of U.S. adults reporting that contraception should be covered at least partly by health insurance, according to a Harris Interactive poll. More women than men supported some level of insurance coverage for contraceptives and procedures, and 88 percent of women said they should cover 25 percent of costs. In addition, about 63 percent of adults supported certain amounts of coverage for in vitro fertilization, 25 percent opposed full insurance coverage of the procedure, and 13 percent were unsure. Again, more women than men supported some level of insurance coverage for in vitro fertilization, but fewer men than women supported full insurance coverage. The survey also found that insurance should cover drug treatment for adult urinary dysfunction and other sexual dysfunction. The U.S. adult population supports the use of drug to treat sexual dysfunction, at least in part. The results are based on a nationwide online survey of 2,402 adults. Senator Target Tobacco Seller has asked the Federal Trade Commission to investigate R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Inc. for marketing its products to children. In a letter to the FTC, Senators Tom Herkin (D-Iowa) and Senator Frank Rothberg (D-N.J.) R.J. Reynolds said he was trying to attract young girls to Camel No.9 cigarettes. It is advertised as light and sweetness in popular women's magazines. The senator said the advertising campaign was aimed at appealing to teen girls, who make up more than 10 percent of readers of women's magazines. The tenacity of advertising that smokes to young people is simply unacceptable, Senator Herkin said in a statement. We can't tolerate advertising that encourages young people to act illegally and harm their health, said tobacco companies, also criticized by the Women's Health Research Association for camel No.9 marketing, with the group clearly aiming to attract a new generation of young female smokers. However, a spokesman for R.J. Reynolds said company officials are confident that their marketing practices comply with all FTC guidelines. Wemes recently named Kelly N. Weems, a 24-year veteran of the Department of Health and Human Services, who leads the Medicare Medicaid Service Center.
