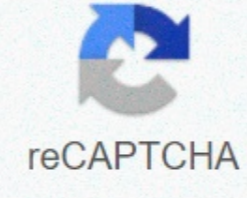

Answer: Both Phoebe and Allie had red hair, so Holden's hunter's red cap, with his childish echoes, is his way of reunited with both of them and preserving his innocence. 5 Why does Holden finally leave Pencey? Answer: Holden is kicked out for not too many classes, but he eventually chooses to leave early to get rid of all the fonies that make him unhappy. Specifically, he runs away from Stradlater, who has co-opted the only girl he really loves, Jane Gallagher. 6 What are some of the things that kill Holden in his words? Answer: In general, the things that make Holden feel emotional (killing him) involve children. When she reads Phoebe's notebook, or when she remembers Allie's weaknesses, she can't block the emotions that go beyond her defense. 7 Why does Holden cling so deeply to the innocence of children? Answer: Holden has yet to recover from the strong cruelties of adulthood that so quickly stripped him of the innocence of childhood. Allie was cruelly taken away from him, and then Holden had to immediately venture to the school, where he was mocked by his classmates. Holden can't see a way to regain his childhood innocence. 8 Why can't Holden force himself to go to a place with the prostitute who comes to his motel room? Answer: Holden simply wants the comfort of someone he can talk to. He can't bring himself to numb loneliness and pain long enough to sleep with someone. On top of that, he's a virgin, so it's pretty obvious he wants the first time to be special. 9 Why Holden finally lash at Sally Hawkins? Answer: Although Sally is pretty nice and Holden enjoys having her on his arm, in the end he can't mess with her phoniness. Sally cares about appearances and superficial pitfalls of status, but Holden only cares about having someone to relate to. He'd rather be alone than commit to a fake. 10 Why does Holden finally capitulate and return home with Phoebe at the end? Answer: Holden wants to distance himself from people as much as possible so that he doesn't have to experience the pain of loving someone and then losing them again. After Allie, she can't have a heartache. He wants to save himself from the pain of losing Phoebe or seeing her grow up, getting as close as possible to her. But when she insists on accompanying him, Holden can't bear to destroy his life, either by letting her come with him or by leaving without her. The boy sings if a body catches a body passing through the rye, a song that inspires Holden's fantasy of sitting in a rye field where the children play, holding them fall off a cliff. However, Phoebe later corrects Holden that the actual lyrics of the song are, if a body meets a body that comes through the rye. When Holden dreams of becoming the rye catcher, he imagines himself preserving the innocence of his childhood. Holden might also want to save others because he failed to save Allie and he fails to save himself.
