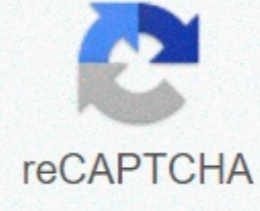

The envelopes are from the 1840s and remain a major part of business correspondence. Envelopes are available in different styles, as well as sizes for users' needs. Business people can usually choose envelopes that require very easily because they come in several standard sizes. Envelopes used by companies and organizations usually fall into one of two categories: those used for regular business correspondence and money transfers. The dimensions of business correspondence begin the smallest, designated small company or 6 1/4, which measures 3.5 x 6 inches. The largest standard envelope size is #14, which is 5 by 11.5 inches. The #10 is the most widely used envelope for business correspondence and measures 4 1/8-x 9.5 inches. Money transfer envelopes are usually used to bill customers and provide pre-addressed payment return envelopes. The smallest change envelope, marked as 6 1/4, has dimensions 3.5 by 6 inches. The largest commonly used cash envelope is #9, which measures 3 7/8-x 8 7/8 inches. The two standard size of the playing cards are the size of the poker and the size of the bridge. Poker cards for play are 2.5 inches long and 3.5 inches long. The bridge-sized maps are 2.25 inches wide, 3.5 inches long. Casinos use standard cards to play on many of their tables. These cards are thinner than poker cards, making them easier to operate, shuffle and distribute. Poker cards are used for most card games. Other game card sizes are also manufactured to suit different apps. Solitaire game cards are available in a compact size, making them easy to transport in a bag or bag and measure just 1.75 inches wide by 2.625 inches long. Larger cards are used to perform magic tricks.
