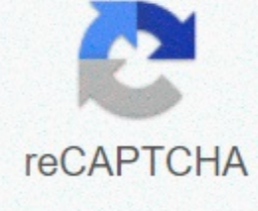

Here are some that you can start playing with your friends, locally or globally. Streets of Rage 4 The first three Streets of Rage games were released on Sega Genesis in the early 1990s. They were as impactful in the side scrolling and beat-em-up genre as 1989's River City Ransom. Released more than 25 years after the third part, Streets of Rage 4 comes from a different developer, but benefits from decades of improvements in overall game design. You can fight alongside, or against, up to four friends locally or online. There is also an arsenal of new deadly moves to master and classic characters. The original composers of the beloved electronic dance soundtrack, Yuzo Koshiro and Hotohiro Kawashima, returned for the fourth part. They are joined by a number of artists invited to provide a hype soundtrack, as you and your friends take on the criminals who run Wood Oak City. The gameplay is smooth enough for complex combos or mashing of basic buttons, and everything is brought to life in a beautiful and hand-drawn art style. In 2019, River City Girls renewed all classic gameplay in a new release in this famous Kunio-kun series. This time, the girls, Kyoko and Misako, have to rescue the boys. With much deeper RPG elements than the original game, River City Girls lets you upgrade your chicas and weapons as you and a friend progress through the 16-bit worlds.
