The vehicle descriptor (characters 4-8) The following 5 characters provide information about the type and size of the vehicle engine, as well as the type of model, restraint, transmission and bodywork. These characters have different meanings, depending on the brand of the car. As such, the number one for Suzuki Philippines will be different from the number one of another brand. Character number 9 The number of characters 9 or the verification figure is the security code of the machine, so it is provided by the manufacturer. Vehicle identification section (characters 10-17) The tenth character is the year in which the vehicle was manufactured and there is a table used for it. The 11th character refers to the specific installation in which the machine was manufactured, while the other characters are the serial number of the machine. Decoding is fun!
