By Daniel Westlake A movie soundtrack is one of the most important parts of a film, but few people know how or where to download it. You can buy tracks at iTunes or AmazonMP3. However, there are a number of online sites where you can download that incredible movie soundtrack you heard in that film the other day. All you have to do is identify the movie, the composer, and look at one of these sites. An extensive database that goes beyond the opening theme song, the song about the credits or the tune all the characters dance to - it features the less eye-catching numbers from a film that only real fans will recognize. With more than 45,000 titles to choose from, SoundtrackCollector.com is for the serious musician and soundtrack enthusiast who is truly a fan of composers and the often brilliant and undervalued work they do for each film. With what could be the largest database of movie soundtracks online, ArtistDirect.com offers most of these downloads for free (with a fee to be paid for access to others). However, most soundtracks that are easiest to find are mainstream pop songs bought for the soundtrack, not necessarily from composers who did movie scores. Keep this in mind if you're looking for something pretty obscure. Last.fm seems to have the most music clips in his database - the challenge comes with finding those tracks. If you're going to Last.fm money to track your soundtracks, all the query information has available to track it. Some of the titles are listed by film, some are listed by composer and others are only listed by title. Don't be discouraged if you can't find it at first - or just use one of the other sites listed above. Some streaming services have existed for years without the option to download shows and movies for offline viewing, but that functionality was available on Day 1 on Disney+. There are more than 600 titles to dive in, enough to binge hundreds of hours from The Simpsons without even watching a fifth of what's available. Ideal for airplane rides and frustrating data spending, the service's download feature - which is exclusive to the mobile apps as of this writing - is so simple that even Olaf can use it, and with each title eligible, it's just a matter of figuring out what you want. Here we'll take you through the process of both downloading and removing movies and screenings from your Disney+ app. Explore Disney+ Download of movies and shows on Disney+Step 1: Choose your download quality Before we have our fun, let's talk about file sizes. If you're hurling for storage space on your iPhone or Android smartphone, Disney+ includes a variable quality feature that lets you sacrifice visual fidelity for a smaller digital footprint. Make Disney+ app on your smartphone (iOS, Android) opens and click on your profile icon at the bottom right. From there, down, app settings to > load. You'll see options for standard, medium and high, the latter probably doesn't offer higher than 1080p resolution. Step 2: Download your content because you can see every Disney+ title offline, no guesswork or filter is required to find downloadable content. The hardest part about this particular task is finding out what you want to watch. Once you've figured it out, you just need to do it from the movie or show's listing, tap the download button, which is located far right of the Play button below the title's logo. For shows, you can also find a separate download button next to each episode if you don't want all season. Disney takes care of the magic from there. It's a relatively fast download on Wi-Fi, especially at the lower properties, so you can probably snag dozens of movies in those few hours before your flight if you forgot to do it the night before. Step 3: Watch your downloaded movies and show All that's left to do now is enjoy yourself! An easy way to find your downloads is by hitting the download icon, which is always visible at the bottom right of the Disney+ app. All of your content will be listed here, sorted by when you're downloaded. Tap the play button on the thumbnail of everything you want to watch, and go from you. Episodes are listed a little differently - they're located under a single label, and tapping it will offer all the episodes you've downloaded for that show, grouped through season. You can also find these titles by regular searching and browsing. You'll know something is available for offline viewing if you see a smartphone icon where the download button usually sits. How much space do I need? The amount of storage space each title eats is mostly based on video length and resolution, and with other variables playing into the equation - the largest is your quality environment - this number can vary greatly. We've downloaded three movies of similar length and resolution - a few of the Star Wars films, clocking in at just over two hours each - to see how each of the options affects file size. The Empire Strikes Back on standard quality was 0.92GB for a 2-hour, 7-minute runtime, while a New Hope on medium needed 1.4GB for 2 hours and 4 minutes. That's a modest jump compared to Return of the Jedi at high quality, which needs 5.5GB for 2 hours and 14 minutes. For shows, a 39-minute episode of The Mandalorian takes on high quality 1.5GB, but just 270MB on standard and 424MB on medium. Finally, at a 3-hour, 1-minute runtime, The Avengers: End Game needs a whopping 7.1GB. Using the data above, you can work out a rough estimate of how much space you need to store everything you want. You can mix and match by adjusting your quality setting before initiating the download. Now will also be an excellent time whether you need a Wi-Fi to download content, an option that is definitely considered on limited data should be considered. Disney+ enables Wi-Fi-only downloads by default. What is available? As explained above, everything in the Disney+ catalog can be downloaded for offline consumption. Whether it's an entire season of Darkwing Duck or every single movie of the Marvel Cinematic Universe, if it's on Disney+, you can download it. Unlike some other services, Disney+ is pretty loose for restrictions. To begin with, you can download a single title on up to 10 different devices at a time, and you can download it as often as you like. The only thing Disney asks is that you connect to Disney+ every 30 days. How do I delete titles? Eventually, you'll want to make room for something new. Whether you want to remove a single title or a bunch of everything at once, Disney+ makes the task delightfully simple. Step 1: Remove a single title When you want to swipe titles from your device, the process is much simpler than downloading files. In fact, it will only take you a few seconds to remove something from Disney+. First, find your content by heading to the download section. You can access the download area by typing the second icon from the right onto the app's navigation bar. Locate the movie you want to delete and click on the smartphone icon to the right of its title. Select Remove Download, and the title will escort itself right from your smartphone's storage. If you delete a few movies or shows, it's a simple way to do it. Step 2: Removing all titles We offer you two effective methods to completely remove different titles from your Disney+ page. From the Downloads section, select Edit - located on the right side of the screen. At this point, you'll see squares next to each title on your list, which you can click on to select the title it represents. You can click on as many squares as you want to remove as many corresponding titles, and if you're ready, you simply click on the trash icon option to eliminate them forever. Similarly, you can click the Select All button to select titles to remove. If you click the Select All button a second time, it will deselect all your titles. If you're looking for an even faster mass deletion solution, Disney+ offers it. You can press your profile icon at the bottom right and print app settings and delete > all downloads. This option allows you to trash everything with one button, lying more room for which new titles you'd like to download next. You don't have to put a TV to watch unmissable movies or can't miss TV shows because you can watch Netflix on your smartphone or tablet, giving your wearable access to thousands of hours of entertainment. However, not everyone has a high-speed mobile internet access that Netflix can stream on the road. Netflix solves this problem by giving its subscribers the opportunity to download Netflix content as long as a Netflix subscription is active. If you want to know how to download from Netflix, that's what you need to do. How to download from Netflix on Windows If you want to download Netflix shows and movies on a Windows 10 PC, you must first download and install the Netflix app from the Microsoft Store. This will require you to sign up with your Netflix username and password, as well as an active Netflix subscription. Once the Netflix app is installed on your computer, open the TV show or movie you want to download. On the information page before you start playing, press the Download icon. You must repeat this for each individual episode of a TV show that you want to download. Once a download has started, you can break or cancel it by printing the circular progress icon that replaces the download icon. Select Pause from the drop-down menu to pause the download or cancel Download to cancel it. You can also see the progress of current downloads, as well as see a list of completed downloads, from the My Downloads menu. If your download is up and running, press the Download progress bar at the bottom of the Netflix app to access this list. You can also access this menu by pressing the hamburger menu icon on the left and then pressing the My Downloads option. In the My Downloads menu, a list of downloads will be visible. An option called Smart Downloads will be visible in the top right corner. This option ensures that the next available TV show in a series will always be downloaded when you're connected to a network while simultaneously deleting a previously watched episode. That's to help limit Netflix's data storage usage. If you want to disable this option, tap the Smart Downloads option, then press the Enable Smart Downloads slider to the off position. To start playing a downloaded TV show or movie, press one of the options in the Me and then press the play play in the middle of the content thumbnail. To delete the contents, press the tick icon in the lower-right corner, and then select the Delete download option. It is advisable to follow these steps and download from Netflix over an ethernet or WiFi connection, ensuring that your Internet connection does not have a data cap or limit in place. Download from Netflix On Android, iPhone, or iPad If you have an Android, iPhone or iPad device, you can download the Netflix mobile app. Like the Microsoft Store app for Windows 10, this mobile application supports offline downloads, so you can see your favorite Netflix shows on the move. Once Netflix is signed in to your mobile device, select the content you want to download. Tap the Download button to start downloading, located at the top of the information menu under the Play button. For TV shows, you can also scroll down and print the download icon alongside individual episodes. To view information about previous and current downloads, tap the Downloads tab in the lower menu bar. At the top of the Downloads tab is the Smart Downloads option. This option ensures that the next available episode of a series is downloaded when watching an episode (delete the watched episode in the process). Tap this option, and then tap the Smart Downloads slider in the following menu to disable it if you prefer to handle it yourself. In the Downloads menu, your list of downloaded shows and movies will be visible. Tap any of the downloaded shows or movies to access your content. To play the downloaded Netflix content, press the play icon in the middle of the thumbnail. If you want to delete the downloaded content, tap the tick icon next to it instead - it will bring options to Play or delete them. Tap the Delete Download option from the menu to remove it. You can customize the quality of Netflix episodes or movies you download from the Netflix Settings menu. To access this menu, tap > Application Settings. In the Downloads menu, you can choose to download content only from WiFi connections by tapping the Wi-Fi Only slider. To customize your download video quality and location, tap the Download Video Quality or Download Location Options. In the Download Video Quality menu, tap either Standard or High to switch between these quality options. Selecting Standard (the default option) will allow for faster downloads. If you want to increase the quality, choose Rather High, although these downloads will take longer and use more internal storage. If you want to remove all the downloaded movies or shows from your device, tap the Delete all downloads option. Tap OK to confirm that you want to do this in the following menu. How to download from Netflix On Mac While iPhone and iPad users are able to download from Netflix with From the official Netflix app, there isn't a suitable option for Mac users. You can stream content from the Netflix website your web browser, but you cannot download the content to your device for offline viewing. No app - no downloads. Mac users are left out of the cold on this one, with no suitable option to get the problem other than trying screen recordings. This is a potential legal grey area, so it's not an option we can recommend (and will likely result in lower quality videos anyway). By using streaming platforms on the go with a Netflix subscription and a mobile device, you're free to binge your favorite shows and movies without an internet connection once you know how to download from Netflix. This will store your data for more important things, such as using a mobile hotspot for your laptop. If you keep close to home, don't worry - you can stream Netflix to your TV using all sorts of devices, from your own smartphone to Apple TV. Other services are also available, including Apple+ and Hulu. Like Netflix, you can see Hulu shows offline to store your data and keep watching even when your connection is weak. Poor.
